

DEMONSTRATION IS TO BE STAGED BY SOCIALIST PARTY

New York, May 10.—(I. N. S.)—The Socialist convention here today formulated plans for a gigantic demonstration in Washington on Saturday in protest against the "political imprisonment" of Eugene V. Debs, who will be the party's 1920 presidential candidate.

A committee was appointed today composed of Morris Hillquit of New York, Seymour Stedman of Chicago, Otto Branstetter, executive secretary; George Rohr of Massachusetts and Freda Hogan of Oklahoma to interview Attorney General Palmer Friday and request amnesty for all political prisoners now serving sentences for violation of war-time laws and particularly amnesty for Eugene V. Debs.

Another interview has been arranged with Secretary Joseph P. Tumulty at the White House Saturday with the object in view of laying the Debs case before the president for executive clemency.

Eight thousand Socialists who paid their way into Madison Square Garden here Sunday to hear Morris Hillquit, Victor Berger and Seymour Stedman in the opening of the Socialist national campaign, wildly cheered the declaration by Stedman that the war against Germany was a crime and the St. Louis platform of the Socialist party adopted in 1917 denouncing American entry into the war was a "document of honor."

They rose to their feet in a great demonstration for Victor Berger, who declared he was "Congressman from Milwaukee despite the house of capitalist representatives, Woodrow Wilson and my friend Attorney General Palmer."

Poland was booed and a great cheer given for soviet Russia.
