

### PUBLIC SCHOOLS' EXHIBITS OFFER OBJECT LESSONS

In an effort to bring to the attention of every person in Portland some of the work done in the public schools, those subjects that can best be visualized will form the basis of a unique "live" exhibit, which opens today in the windows of 30 leading downtown stores and continue until Saturday evening.

The exhibit, arranged under supervision of Miss Harriet Thayer and Miss Edith Darling and several supervisors of departments, represents merely the class room work rather than a display for exhibition purposes.

**EXHIBITS ARE PLACED.**  
The Meier & Frank company has given two windows, in one of which will be demonstrations of cooking and sewing. Electric ranges are being installed, also kitchen cabinets, tables, etc., and the work of preparing foodstuffs will be done in the windows by the students, the girls writing their recipes on a blackboard.

The classes in sewing will cut, fit and make garments in the window work rooms. In a second window will be a demonstration of the work carried on at the A. L. Mills open air school.

Pupils of the technical department of the Washington high school will demonstrate mechanical drawing in the window of the J. K. Gill company. A writing demonstration will be held at Woodward & Clarke's. The elementary sewing classes will work in the windows of Olds, Wortman & King. The Benson Polytechnic school will have a display and demonstration from its shops in the windows of Jenning & Sons. The millinery department of the Girls' Polytechnic school will make hats in the window of the United Apparel company. Card writing and cartooning will be shown at the C. J. Mathis store.

**DIVERSITY IS SEEN.**  
Physical and recreational work will be given at Sherman Clay & Co. The art department will be in Feldenhimer's window and in Aronson's window will be shown arts and crafts jewelry. A window in the Lion Clothing company will be fitted up like a typical office for pupils of the Commercial high school.

At Gadsby & Son will be a cooking demonstration and in another pupils from the school for the blind will be at work. At Powers', Kilham's and Ed-

wards' will be demonstrated work of the high schools. The Girls' Polytechnic school will have a display at Simpson's. Lipman-Wolfe, Wonder Millinery company and at the Eastern Outfitting company. Boys' and girls' club work will be demonstrated in the Hon-

eyman window. Here, too, will be a demonstration of camp cookery. Other windows to be used are Roberts', Shanahan's, Greenfield Shoe company, Gray Clothing company and Kathryn Coffee, Ungar's store, the Emporium and in the Curran drug store at 86 Johns

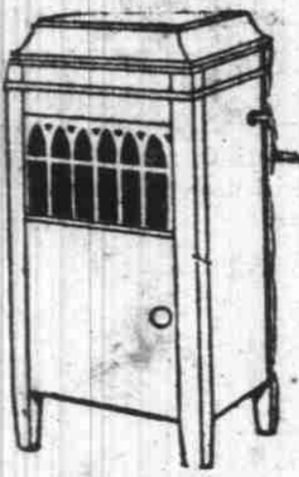

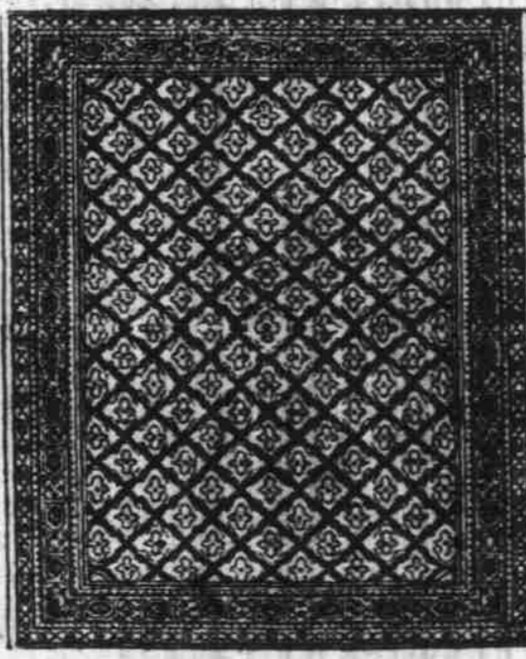
