

PLEA OF GERMANY TO BE PRESENTED TO ALLIES AT SPA

Berlin, May 10.—(U. P.)—(Delayed.)—Germany desires to lay all her cards openly on the table at the Spa conference, May 25, Dr. Adolph Koester, former minister, said in an interview today.

The German government hopes to clear up the following points, Koester said:

First—Germany's exact economic position.

Second—The German financial situation and the food and raw stuffs problem.

Third—The necessity for security and internal peace.

WOULD SHOW NEEDS
Koester expressed hope that Germany would be admitted to the conference with full powers to enter into all discussions. If she is admitted only as a "listener," he said, then she must send delegates instructed accordingly, for their sole duty will be to receive the accomplished decisions of the allied leaders. But, the former minister believed the Spa conference will mean for the time direct verbal negotiations concerning fulfillment of the treaty of Versailles.

Koester hoped the Spa conference would not be "Versailles over again on a smaller scale."

"We expect to be able to show the entente exactly what Germany's economic situation is, what her financial situation is and what she is able to do in the way of food, raw materials and internal security," Koester said.

NOT ENOUGH SOLDIERS
"As to the latter, I will be quite happy if the entente can show us a way whereby we can maintain order with only 20,000 men and no cannon."

"I hope the Spa meeting will result in a solution for fulfillment of the treaty. We do not expect to go to Belgium with any other idea."

"We do not mean Germany must suffer in fulfillment of the treaty. We were beaten and we are willing to pay the price of defeat."

"But we do mean and hope the conclusion has come to France and England that only on a basis of justice and common understanding can the treaty be worked out satisfactorily."

MUST HAVE SHIPS
"We mean France must not expect Germany to pay all her taxes, but agree to some basis for Germany to fulfill the obligations she is able to meet. For instance, we shall expect the entente to make terms under which it expects us to operate."

"It would be absurd to think, Koester said, the entente expected Germany to work any sort of economic rehabilitation without a merchant fleet."

The coal fields of upper Silesia, he said, should remain in German hands, as they are essential to her economic life.

Kaiser's Favorite
Goosestep Revived
By Republic's Army

Stettin, Pomerania, May 14.—The real old-fashioned goose step, in which the Kaiser used to be able to march, was revived in this city by the renaissance of the Kaiser's old guardmount (hauptwache), and thought, I was back in Berlin in the days before the war. The goose-stepping of these steel-helmeted soldiers of the German republic was quite up to the mark, and their comrades who had sworn fidelity to the Kaiser in 1914. The swing of their legs and snap of their arms as they goose-stepped and presented arms when officers passed seemed decidedly out of date, considering that revolution in November, 1918, which compelled the Kaiser to flee.

Before I saw the guardmount I observed from my hotel a regiment of soldiers pass by in a brass band playing Wilhelm's favorite march, "Des Kaiser-marsch." These same troops have left the job of guarding Germany's democracy.

Living Costs Mount
In England; War on
Profiteers a Failure

London, May 14.—In spite of an elaborate system of tribunals created to prosecute cases of profiteering, a system which has thus far proved unsuccessful, the cost of living in England is gradually increasing, although prices for eggs, butter, milk and vegetables are temporarily somewhat lower.

Government officials predict that for at least two years prices will be higher than they are at present. A boost in household coal of \$3.50 a ton becomes effective Wednesday, and coal for industries will go up a dollar at the same time.

This, it is said, will bring a proportionate rise in the cost of all imported foodstuffs and canned goods are increased 25 per cent owing to the difference in exchange. The promised decrease in meat prices has not yet materialized, although warehouses are glutted with meat.

Eastern bureau of the foreign office, who explained that the treaty may be continued automatically for one year periods, dating from the day of expiration. They do not look for any suggestions from Japan to materially revise the treaty because its provisions are largely in her favor and, furthermore, because any new treaties are to be submitted to the League of Nations. It would be superfluous to revise the document now.

Officials characterize Japan's activities in Siberia and Manchuria as "most obscure and mysterious." No light has been thrown upon reports that several Japanese divisions of troops have arrived at Harbin, China, in civilian clothes. There is considerable official interest in this project.

Turkish Nationalist
Movement Growing
Despite Government

Constantinople, Turkey, May 14.—(Copyright, 1920, by Chicago Daily News Co.) In spite of all kinds of anathemas and proclamations launched by the Turkish government and the sultan, the nationalist movement is daily growing stronger. Constantinople is covered with proclamations issued from the nationalist headquarters denouncing the government as traitorous to the nation and asking all good Mussulmans to fight.

Meanwhile the ranks of the nationalists are reinforced by crowds of officers who join in the movement. All Fuad Pasha, commander of the twentieth army corps, has gone over to the nationalists and is organizing a force. The government seems to be powerless but tries to persuade all to benefit from the seven days' grace given by the sultan to those who express a desire to obey the government. A messenger has been sent to Adrianople to induce Jaffer Tatar, the rebellious governor, to come to Constantinople and get the benefit of a pardon.

The situation in the interior, especially in Cilicia is serious. The arrival of an American cruiser at Adana has not greatly affected the position of the Armenians. The American relief committee has called for assistance, as nationalist bands are threatening to encircle it.

From Reporter to
Millionaire Brings
Kiley Fame Abroad

Paris, May 14.—Gerald Kiley, who was first the dance and then the ice cream king of Paris, has made so much money out of his ice cream business that he has established near Havre a large factory for the manufacture of American syrups. Kiley was formerly a reporter in Chicago.

In two years Kiley has made more than a million. He went to England recently to sell a few thousand barrels of lime juice he had acquired from the Y. M. C. A. in Paris.

In London they offered him a profit of a million francs on the barrels providing he could get them the sugar with which to turn the juice into syrup.

The British government intervened and Kiley was forbidden to import the

sugar into the British Isles. Now he is turning the juice into syrup down in Normandy and exporting it to London at double the price he would have received for it had he sold it direct.
