

DRIVE FOR 1000 MEMBERS TO BE BEGUN MAY 25

Chamber of Commerce Has 2000 Prospects Lined Up; City to Be Canvassed by Workers.

In an effort to bring the membership of the Chamber of Commerce from the present mark of about 3300 to 4000 or better, the membership department of the organization has decided to launch a drive during the next week to this month, May 25 to inclusive, concentrating on 2000 prospects which the membership workers have reported during the last few months.

The preliminary survey of the entire business section of the city has just been completed by the membership committee, under the chairmanship of Frank E. Andrews. This method has been employed to secure an accurate list of about 3 prospects in each of the 1000 business blocks of the city. The 2000 prospect cards which have been obtained through this canvass will be placed in the hands of 200 volunteer workers, who have offered their services for the campaign. These men will not only make the most systematic and thorough canvass of the business section of the city ever made, but will also be in the main driving room of the campaign. On the evening of May 23, at which time they will receive instructions and details of the drive, H. B. Duser, secretary of the chamber, and other business men, will address the gathering and supply material for presentation to the prospects.

Arrangements are being made for special advertising features, that the campaign may be called to the attention of the business men.

Andrews, chairman of the membership committee, and W. H. Barton, secretary, will have charge of the drive. The city has been divided into districts as follows: District No. 1, west side, north of Stark street—E. C. Simmons, director; district No. 2, west side, south of Stark street—L. E. Williams, director; district No. 3, east side, south of Stark street, John Schibel, director.
