

PROSPECT FOR AIR PATROL HELD GOOD

Eugene, May 21.—At the Thursday luncheon of the Chamber of Commerce honor guests were Colonel H. H. Arnold, commanding the western division of the air service; District Forester Cecil of Portland; State Forester Elliott of Salem; Colonel Chapman of Portland, connected with the forest service in the Northwest; and A. G. Jackson of the educational department of the forest service.

Addresses were delivered in the interest of the proposed municipal flying field at Eugene, the establishment of federal air patrol for the protection of the forests, and the observance of "Forest Protection Week." The speakers gave much encouragement as to the prospects of securing an extension of the air patrol to Oregon.

J. D. Hill and W. L. O'Neill, Portland aviators, arrived on the Eugene flying field about noon, having driven two Curtiss planes from the metropolis in an hour and 45 minutes, fighting a high wind all the way. They took part in the maneuvers of the flying circus of the day.

The Lane County Jersey Cattle club met Thursday with Professor E. B. Pitts of the agricultural college, and Ira P. Whitney, county agricultural agent, as speakers. Plans were discussed for a summer picnic of dairymen and their families, and a trip to the dairy center at Sheed. An exhibition will be arranged for the county fair and the club plans an educational booth at the state fair. Special attention was given to the work of the calf clubs in the county.

Ex-Ambassador Is Murdered by Carranza Troops

Mexico City, May 21.—(I. N. S.)—Ambassador Bonillas, former envoy to the United States and candidate for the Mexican presidency, has been murdered by Carranzistas at Malpas, in Puebla, according to an unconfirmed report.

Bonillas, the report said, had fled to the mountains in that state, where he was overtaken and slain by the former first chief's followers. The murder is reported as having taken place last night.

Carranza is now at Tetela De Ocampo, in the state of Puebla, advices reaching this city declined today. Only a handful of men are with him.
