

### CITY CALLS HALT ON WORK COSTING SOME \$3,000,000

City commissioners Thursday afternoon ordered discontinuance of \$3,000,000 worth of street, sewer and park improvement projects following the failure of bond buyers to submit any bids on two recent offers of municipal bonds.

This is the first time in history that municipal bonds have not found a purchaser. Bonds must be sold at par, bearing not to exceed 6 per cent interest, under charter provisions.

#### BOND HOUSES REFUSE

Bond houses have refused to enter bids on the bonds, citing the unstable condition of the market as the reason.

Sewer contracts amounting to \$1,511,197 and street improvements aggregating \$1,369,203 have been let by the city. Proposed improvement projects estimated to cost \$700,000 have passed the remonstrance period and are now ready to be awarded.

Commissioner Barbur has ordered a complete check of all improvement work not contracted for. This can be halted, it is believed, although some difficulty may be found, say commissioners, in stopping sewer work, which is well on its way to completion. In the event contractors desire to finance their own work, the city will file no objections, despite the fact that warrants issued to contractors on completion of the work cannot be redeemed.

#### STATE FUNDS UNAVAILABLE

State Treasurer Hoff informed city officials Thursday that no funds were available with which to purchase even a portion of the bonds. County commissioners also discovered that their finances were so limited that they could not buy the bonds in any appreciable amount. Negotiations Thursday afternoon with members of the Clearing House association failed to bring any relief, owing to a lack of technical and legal information as to the city's powers. Some effort will be made to work out a feasible plan of disposing of enough bonds with the Clearing House association as soon as definite information is at hand as to what work can be canceled.

Building Community Clubhouse  
Pasco, Wash., May 21.—Out in the Riverview section, where some 60 new families have purchased farms this spring and where some 12,000 acres of new lands are just being brought under irrigation by a new unit of the Franklin county irrigation district, a community club house is being built.

### Veteran General of Four Wars Dies at Seattle, Aged 78

Seattle, May 21.—(L. N. S.)—Brigadier General Frank Taylor, United States army, retired, is dead here today at the age of 78 years. He was born

in Calais, France, of English parents, and entered the United States army in 1865. General Taylor was retired in 1905 at his own request. He served in the Civil war, Indian campaigns, Spanish-American war and the Philippines. Since his retirement General Taylor had made his home with his daughter here.
