

I.O.O.F. ELECTIONS HELD AT SESSIONS OF GRAND LODGE

Baker, May 26.—The total number of delegates to the I. O. O. F. grand lodge convention registering at headquarters Tuesday passed the 800 mark and each train brought recruits to the ranks of those who came on the I. O. O. F. special Tuesday evening, when 600 delegates arrived from all parts of the state.

Monday the Patriarchs Militant elected Lieutenant Colonel A. J. Walther of

Portland vice president of the departmental council and Colonel W. E. Wade of Harrisburg, treasurer. Chevalier J. W. Neil was appointed sentinel and Captain George Holland sentinel. The session Tuesday was devoted to that of the grand encampment and the Rebekahs assembly. The encampment elected: R. P. Kirkpatrick of Pendleton, grand patriarch; K. J. Nolan of Portland, grand high priest; W. E. Wade of Harrisburg, grand senior warden; E. E. Sharon of Portland, grand scribe; W. P. Francis of Albany, grand treasurer; E. P. Light of Lakeview, grand junior warden; R. J. Henderson of Salem, grand marshal; J. C. Crimmins of Freewater, grand sentinel; R. W. Watson of Tillamook, grand outside sentinel; P. A. Hantz of Baker, grand representative sovereign, grand lodge, for two years.

Forty candidates took the encampment degree Tuesday morning. Tuesday evening a banquet of Patriarchs Militant was held, followed by the decoration of chairs upon 64 candidates, the grand reception and the grand ball.

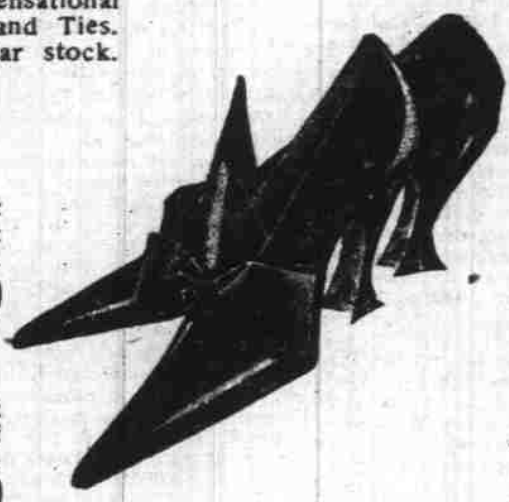

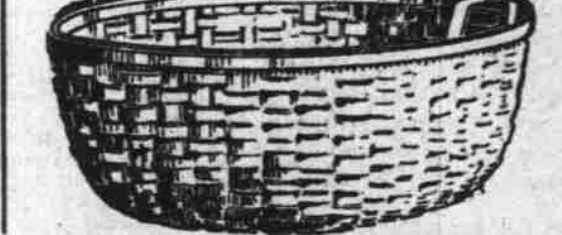
