McINNIS COMMITTS SUICIDE WITH GAS

Alexander McInnis, prominent in Portland as a contractor, committed suicide in his home at 323 Grand avenue north, Thursday afternoon, by locking himself in a bathroom and turning on the gas.

McInnis was a member of the firm of McInnis & Read, which constructed the Multnomah club building, the Buchanan building and other structures here.

About 11 o'clock Thursday morning, Mrs. McInnis went downtown, while McInnis was putting wood into the basement. When she returned, about 3 o'clock, she found no one around the house, and smelled gas when she entered. She found McInnis in the bathroom dead, with the gas turned on. He left no communications.

McInnis underwent an operation for tumor about four years ago, from which he never completely recovered. He was dependent over this and recent heavy financial losses.

McInnis was 66 years old, and is survived by a wife, Esther McInnis, and a son and daughter.

Meredith Indorses Forest Protection Week in Oregon

Appreciation of Governor Olcott's designation of the present forest protection week in Oregon has been expressed by Secretary of Agriculture Meredith in a letter of hearty indorsement to the governor.

"The matter of making adequate provision for the safeguarding and renewal of our forests is of vital importance to the nation," said Meredith. "Our decreasing timber and paper supplies are beginning to make clear to all the need for concerted action, and the states and nation must join hands in the effort to halt forest destruction."

The necessity of forest protection and the inadequacy of present methods of fire prevention will be discussed by J. B. Knapp and R. J. Groce at the meeting of the Portland Realty board in the grillroom of the Portland hotel this noon.

Songs by the Presbyterian church quartet, short talks by the Rev. C. T. Cook and by J. C. Brown of Independence and Hiram Holm of Oakville, and the reading of a poem written for the occasion by Mrs. Sarah A. Matthews, a sister of Mrs. Williamson, who resides in the east, formed the program. Williamson was born in 1842, and Mrs. Williamson in 1851. They were married in Pennsylvania.
