

NEW NAVY RULING GIVES BOYS AT 17 CHANGE TO ENLIST

Instructions just received by Lieutenant P. K. Elder, in charge of the naval recruiting station in the Dekum building, permit the enlistment of boys over 17 years of age who are qualified in other respects and whose parents file their consent in forms provided for the purpose.

The minimum weight required of minors taking the physical examination for enlistment in the United States navy is 120 pounds and the minimum height 52 inches. The term of enlistment may be for the period of minority or for a three year period at the option of the candidate.

A bill recently passed by congress has increased the pay of enlisted men in the navy. Under the new schedule the minimum pay for an enlisted man is \$48 per month and the maximum received by chief petty officers is \$145 per month.

Dry Mass Meeting Called for Quiz of Party Candidates

Chicago, June 5.—(I. N. S.)—A gigantic mass meeting of prohibition forces from all parts of the United States has been called for Chicago June 8, which all presidential candidates will be invited to attend and state their position with reference to the eighteenth amendment.

Declaring that "no political party or candidate could in the year 1920 escape the liquor question," the Prohibition national committee announced that all presidential candidates were being asked the following questions, their answers to be made public when given:

Do you believe in the eighteenth amendment as interpreted by the Volstead act, which act, as you understand, interprets intoxicating liquors to be anything containing more than one half of 1 per cent of alcohol?

Do you favor your party adopting a plank in its national platform endorsing the eighteenth amendment and its enforcement as interpreted by the Volstead act, or some other measure equally effective?

Democrats Chosen To Put Candidates Before Convention

Liquor Cases Not To Be Decided 'Till Elections Are Over

Washington, June 5.—(I. N. S.)—The United States supreme court may not hand down a decision in the liquor cases until next December, because of the political issues involved.

Close students of the ways of the court and of the strict adherence of its members to precedents are making this prediction freely today, in view of the delay of the court in rendering its decision on the constitutionality of the prohibition amendment and on the validity of the Volstead enforcement act.

The liquor question, it was pointed out, is an issue in the political campaigns now being waged and will continue to be an issue in the greater campaign coming after the presidential and congressional nominations.

The presidential nominations are now imminent. There always has been a studied determination on the part of the supreme court justices to hold the court aloof from political issues and to prevent its decisions being made the football of partisan politics.

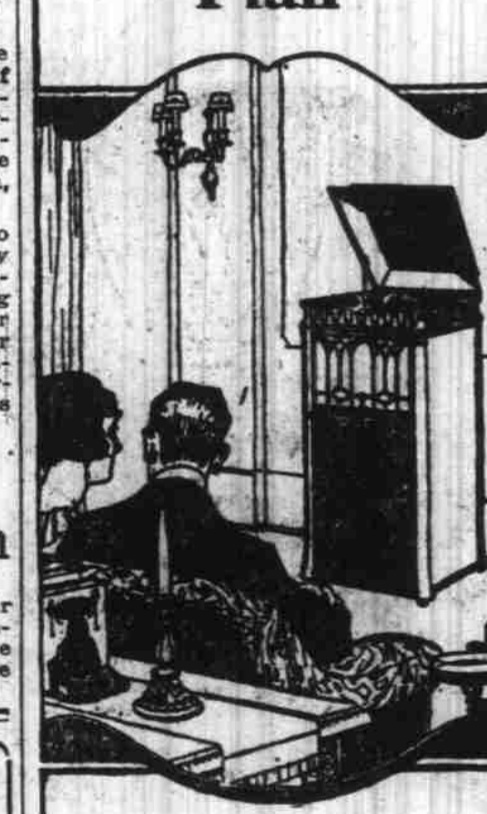
Policemen patrolling the river and lake banks added another description to the list of persons for whose bodies they keep constant watch.

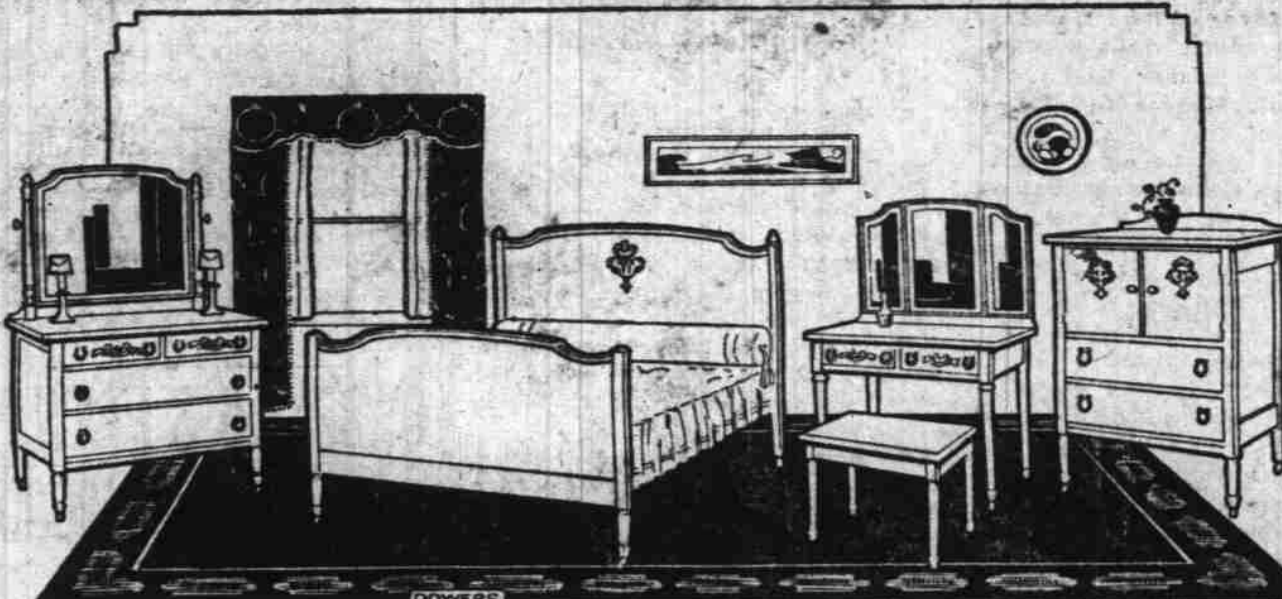
