

SOFT SHOWERS REVIVE PROSPECTS ON NORTHWEST FARMS

EGGS ARE SOFTENED BY MIXED

One local firm has secured a government order for 450 cases of eggs and it has been the high bidder for supplies during the day. Otherwise buyers have been inclined to shade their quotations again. For that reason values for the day are mixed:

Surprising figures are shown of cold storage holdings of both butter and eggs in Portland and Seattle. According to an investigation made by a local cranny the figures show a total that was unexpected.

The total storage of eggs in Seattle, and Portland on May 31, 1919, was 7,951 cases, while on the same date this year the holdings were 62,487 cases, indicating a shortage this year as compared with last year of 16,254 cases in the same date.

The figures show that in the past year the cold storage holdings of eggs in the city of Seattle have increased from 54,000 cases to 62,487 cases, an increase of 8,487 cases.

In Seattle the increase from May 22, 1920, to May 31, 1920, was 2,543 to 35,030, an increase of 11,250 cases.

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MARKET BASKET

Chickens are actually cheaper than good quality meats at this time and the consumer who misses a treat now with a chicken dinner is not taking advantage of the situation.

For some reason or other there has been a great accumulation of chickens in the wholesale trade and retailers have for that reason been able to purchase supplies at the lowest price for a number of years. This means that if the consumer in view she will see that the supply for the family dinner is purchased at the lowest price.

In some parts of the city advantage is taken of the lower prices by dealers who refuse to sell for less. Consumers are advised that they can purchase cheaper and if one place does not quote the decline, others will be glad to sell. The drop in price is most severe in lightweights, but even for old varieties. The latter are often sold to consumers as the best birds, therefore consumers at the proper price.

The following prices are average ones. Consumers are expected to pay retail prices. Quotations are for the city of Portland. Slightly higher and inferior stock fractionally lower.

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REAGAN TONE IN STOCK TRADE

New York, June 7.—(U. P.)—The New York Stock Exchange in its financial review this afternoon said:

Stocks were in supply from the beginning, although trading was far from animated at any period. There were a few strong spots among the specialties. The shipping and tobacco were more actively sought than the other groups.

The intelligence that the supreme court held the tobacco case to be constitutional came over the wires shortly before 2 o'clock. 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BAKER SHIPS FIRST BUTTER IN BARLOAD LOTS

The butter was made at the Baker plant in eastern Oregon and was the first of the season to be shipped in barload lots.

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
