

BUTLER IS CHOSEN AS COMMANDER OF G. A. R. OF OREGON

Astoria, June 10.—Officers to serve for the coming year were elected Wednesday evening at the business session of the Grand Army of the Republic. J. T. Butler of Portland, whose name was presented by Meade Post No. 2, of that city, was elected commander of the department of Oregon.

Following the custom of the G. A. R. in past years the commander of the post of the convention city was elected senior vice commander. R. N. Abbott, commander of Cushing post, Astoria, was accorded that honor.

Five delegates and five alternates were elected to represent the department of Oregon at the national convention, which is to be held in Atlantic City, N. J., Aug. 10 to 15. One of the delegates elected to the national convention was J. T. Butler of Portland. The other newly elected officers are: Junior vice commander, John Clark of Seattle; surgeon, Dr. J. E. Hall of Portland; inspector, W. N. Morse of Portland; and chaplain, T. Brouillette of Portland.

The feature Wednesday of the four conventions in Astoria was the parade of the Grand Army of the Republic, Daughters of Veterans, the Ladies of the G. A. R., the Women's Relief corps and other organizations.

More than 600 people were in line and the marching of the veterans of '61 was the most impressive sight that had been witnessed here in years. The five and drum corps of the department of Oregon made a hit with the spectators. The 200 armed Civil war veterans, all members of the Grand Army of the Republic, who, despite their years, walked proudly, erect in column of fours, were greeted with cheers all along the line.

A splendid showing was also made by the Daughters of Veterans, who marched in the parade to the number of nearly 200. The Ladies of the G. A. R. and W. R. C. were in line and received their share of homage.

At night an old fashioned dance was held. The orchestra played old fashioned dances.

The day sessions of the Grand Army of the Republic, Ladies of the G. A. R., the Women's Relief corps and the Daughters of Veterans were devoted principally to routine business, the G. A. R. holding closed sessions at the Methodist church in the afternoon, the Ladies of the G. A. R. at the Moose hall, the Women's Relief corps at the Elk's temple and the Daughters of Veterans at the Odd Fellows' hall.

Degrees Conferred Upon 9 Graduates Of Albany College
Albany, June 10.—Seven bachelor of arts degrees, one honorary doctor of laws degree and one diploma in voice were conferred upon graduates of Albany college Wednesday. The program closed an eventful day for the seniors, marked chiefly by receptions. A large crowd attended the commencement. Dr. A. M. Williams, president of the college, delivered the commencement address.

Bachelor of arts degrees were conferred by Dr. Williams on Otto Lag Fox, Arlie Delmer Kildow, Margaret Maehall, Warren Clare Hunter, Anna Marks Lane, David Paulin Martin and Maude Catherine McDaniell. Bernice Hackleman Gilchrist was presented with the diploma in voice. The honorary doctor of laws degree was conferred on Frank L. Brown of New York city, secretary of the World's Sunday School association.

Rent free quarters in the Y. M. C. A. building, offered by Albany Chamber of Commerce, which will also occupy offices there, have been accepted by the Linn County Farm bureau. The building will become a community center, with interests of town and county centered there.

Ogle Confession Believed Untrue By Pendleton Man
Pendleton, June 10.—The confession of James Ogle, that he, and not David Smith, fired the shots which ended the lives of J. N. Burgess and George Peringer at Clatsop county tavern last November, does not tally with the convictions of E. P. Marshall, who escaped the shooting unharmed. Marshall declared that the "middle" sized man, wearing Smith, had fired the shots. He believed Ogle was keeping guests in the other part of the tavern covered with his gun.

Officials of the O-W. R. & N. Co. and Umatilla county have agreed upon surveys for an overhead crossing for the Oregon-Washington highway near Saxe station, where two men were killed last fall in a collision with an inbound freight train. High water last winter washed out a bridge close to the crossing and repairs would cost nearly as much as an overhead crossing, it is said. The improvement will cost between \$25,000 and \$30,000.

Peter Johnson Ends Life
Stevenson, Wash., June 10.—Using a wire clothesline, Peter Johnson committed suicide at Sequim, a station on the North Bank railroad between Collins and Cook, by hanging. He left no friends or relatives that are known and is said at one time to have been an inmate of the Steilacoom hospital.

Bennion Needs Assistant
Pendleton, June 10.—An assistant to County Agricultural Agent Fred Bennion will be hired soon, according to decision of the county farm bureau. He will be hired chiefly with distributing distillate to farmers who have purchased several carloads through the farm bureau, with sulphur demonstrations, weed control, etc. No appointment has been announced.
