

GRADUATION ON SATURDAY FOR REED COLLEGE

Big Cougar Killed At Marmot; Is First Seen in Long Time

An enormous cougar, the body of which alone measured 11 feet 11 inches in length, was slain Thursday evening about 5 o'clock on the Sandy river by Ernest Anchoff and E. H. Thomas, at the dam below the Anchoff home at Marmot, seven miles east of Sandy.

Mrs. Emma Thomas, who is a daughter of Adolph Anchoff, the veteran mountaineer whom home seekers have a mecca for the Maazamas and other lovers of the mountains for many years, telephoned to the Journal imparting the news, this morning. Anchoff and his brother-in-law were working at the dam when the animal appeared. This was the first time a cougar had been seen in that region, which has become more settled in recent years, for a long time. The animal is believed to have emerged from the Bull Run water reserve and down the canyon side to the Sandy.

Portland's Record For Least Robbery Activities Excels

Portland is one of the least robbery-infested cities in the United States, says George D. Bangs, general manager of the Pinkerton National Detective agency, who is in Portland on his annual inspection tour. "Crime is on the increase in the country over," he said, "but this condition follows any great war. Reports in Bangs' office indicate that the Middle West is suffering most at the hands of criminals. One of the newer problems Pinkerton operatives find is the safe crackers who learned to use the acetylene torch in the shipyards. These robbers, with the aid of the small torch, quietly melt the hinges and lock.
