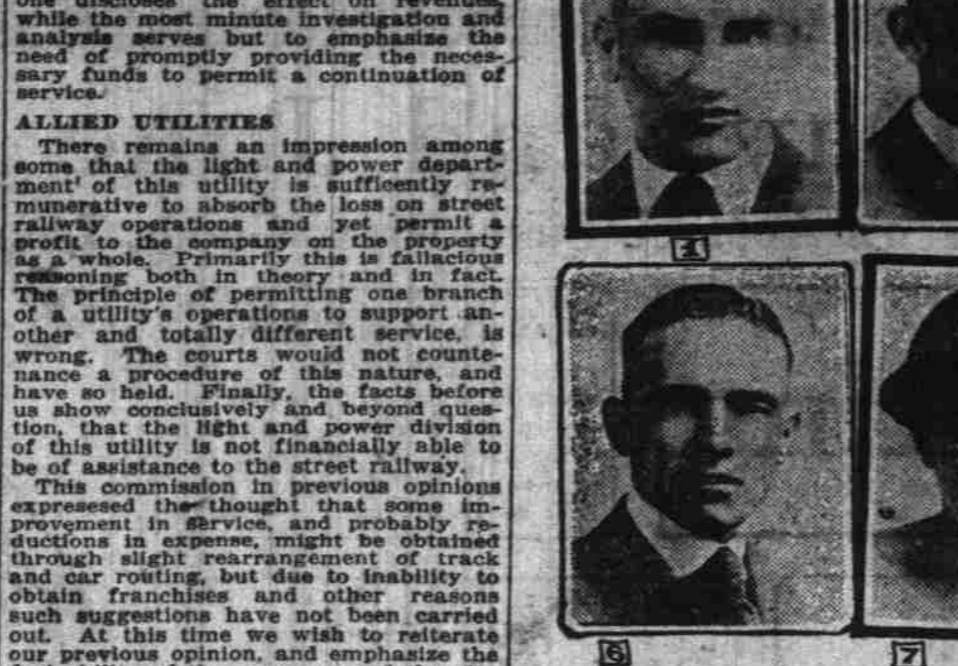


Eight Cent Fare Tuesday Text of Official Order

The public service commission, in the order instituting an eight-cent fare in Portland on June 15, invites the city council and others to take a hand in the railway problem with the ultimate purpose of permanent solution. The order points out that the 8-cent fare is not a solution, but a temporary measure, to be rescinded if other means can be found to continue rapid transit at less cost to riders.

Every month to meet the payroll expenses alone, in addition to which some \$18,000 per month are necessary to pay taxes. In other words, ignoring the costs of materials and supplies, repairs, and all other causes of expense these two items, labor and taxes, require that a revenue in excess of \$270,000 per month be secured to meet them.

Several plans have been suggested and discussed at the various hearings in this case, designed to provide this needed revenue, including, among others, the establishment of a zone system of fares, the collection of a transfer charge in connection with fare increases, and the inauguration of a straight fare increase under a plan similar to that now in effect.
