

STRAWBERRY TIME HAS NOW ARRIVED

Strawberry prices are just about the same but there is a much better quality of stock arriving. Demand from canners is very good at this time and as the berries are now sweet it is the most opportune time to put up whatever stock is needed for the winter.

Within a few days there will be fair supplies of raspberries available as a few small shipments have already been received.

Butter market is very firm and were it not for the fact that the trade is inclined to hold values for the Shriners' convention, an advance would probably be shown at this time. Consumers are advised to put away some stock for the winter.

Chicken market is not quite so low for light weight stock but even at the new prices they are cheaper than the best quality of beef or pork.

Fresh salmon is very scarce and especially for good quality. Columbia river canners have decided that they do not want Portland's visitors to have a taste of fresh Royal Chinook and for that reason have refused the request of wholesale interests here to supply the trade with stock during the festival.

In substance their letters indicate that the canners own the Columbia river far as first call upon the fish supply is concerned.

New potatoes are in reality cheaper than old stock at this time because there is no waste in peeling.
