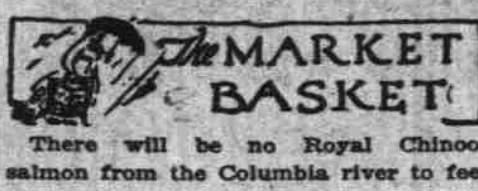

There will be no Royal Chinook salmon from the Columbia river to feed Portland's visitors during the week because the cannerymen of the district have otherwise decided.

Efforts to get them to ship enough of this royal fish to supply the trade during the week have failed because the packers have only selfish motives at this time and every pound they send here they feel is that much profit lost.

Despite the fact that the people pay big money to aid the salmon industry each season, the packers say that the people cannot have any of this fish except in the cans.

At this time most of the fresh salmon available is from other streams and is not of the quality for which the Columbia river and its tributaries is noted.

Wholemeal flour is noted. Some day the people will awaken and force measures whereby they may have a taste of this fish in the fresh state.
