

MEXICAN REBELS OPEN ATTACK ON NUEVO LAREDO

San Antonio, Texas, July 15.—(I. N. S.)—Ricardo Gonzalez, at the head of a force of over 900 rebels, began an attack on Nuevo Laredo, opposite Laredo, Texas, at 8 o'clock this morning. This information was contained in authentic advices just received here.

The besieged town is being defended by a force of about 300 loyal Huerta troops.

Gonzalez' forces were combined at 6 o'clock this morning with approximately 100 filibusters, under command of General Garza, who forded the Rio Grande at a point 10 miles west of Laredo. Customs guards revolted and joined the attacking party.

Man Is Still Given Old Dominion Over Woman and Work

London, July 15.—(I. N. S.)—The biblical position of man as superior in authority to woman was affirmed today by the international Zionist conference, despite the efforts of British women to dethrone him.

It was a victory for the American women attending the conference. The British women, for political purposes, attempted to form an international women's organization, which would be separate from the Zionist movement which has been conducted for years by men.

"If the English proposal were carried out it would be only a duplication of the work already done," said Miss Ida Danziger, one of the American delegates. "We women have already undertaken, at the request of the men, work which obviously belongs to women. We have established nursing and settlement homes, medical clinics and other kinds of relief. But as regards the general work in behalf of the Zionist movement, we prefer to let the men lead and not compete with them."

prove injurious to the public welfare, the interstate commerce commission today announced that it had canceled the proposed increases in through rates on railroads in southern and southeastern territory. The suspension of the increased rates will continue until November 12, unless otherwise ordered by the commission and in the meantime the commission will investigate conditions.

The commission also issued an order today suspending the proposed increased freight rates on potatoes between points in Western trunk line territory until November 12. This order was issued as a result of protests received from shippers that the new rates would be injurious to public interests.

Joint Through Rate For Lumber Asked On Electric Lines

Washington, July 15.—(WASHINGTON BUREAU OF THE JOURNAL.)—In behalf of the Cameron-Hogg Lumber company and other lumbermen along the lines of the Portland Railway, Light & Power company and the Willamette Valley Southern (Clackamas county electric line) J. N. Teal, W. C. McCulloch and Rogers MacVeagh have filed a brief with the interstate commerce commission in support of joint through rates for lumber to eastern destinations.

The brief says the electric lines are willing to establish such rates, but com-

pleting lines refuse, and their refusal caused the failure of an application submitted by the electric carriers to the Portland district freight traffic committee under the railroad administration.

Without such rates, it is stated, the lumber mills on the electric lines are handicapped by the addition of the local rates to the main line junctions and are confined to the sale of ties to the railroads. Through rates in connection with the Northern Pacific, Great Northern, Union Pacific, Spokane, Portland & Seattle and the Milwaukee would enable them to enter the Eastern markets.

Man Sells Family And Furniture to Friends for \$75

Chicago, July 15.—(I. N. S.)—Needing a little ready money, Julius Marowski, several days ago, sold his household furniture to two friends for \$75, tossing in his wife and two daughters for good measure. But a week of undarned socks and unwashed shirts convinced

Julius that he had made a mistake, so he went to his friends and demanded his family back. They refused, whereupon Julius appealed to the police.

The latter, on going to the domicile of Julius' friends today, discovered a moonshine still stilling right merrily, and pinched the house. The family of Julius was turned over to him, together with a copy of the emancipation act and advice that he observe it hereafter.

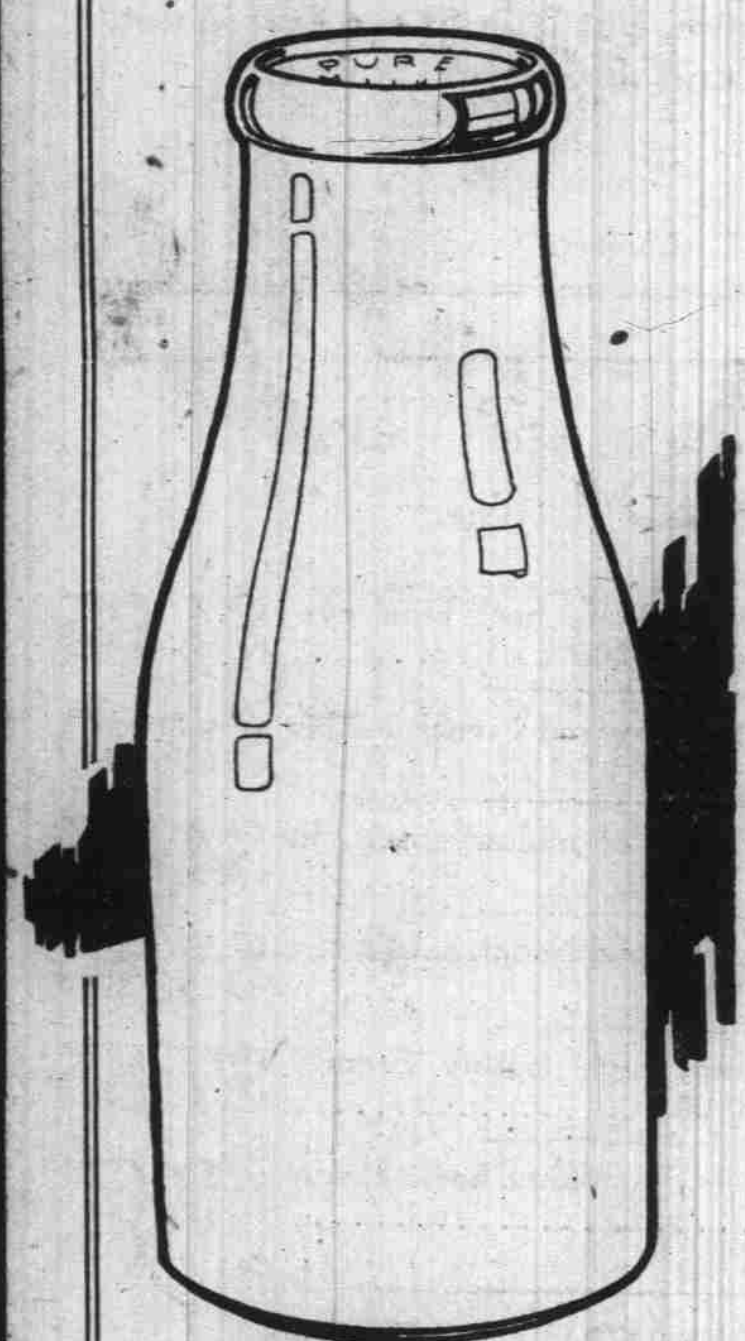

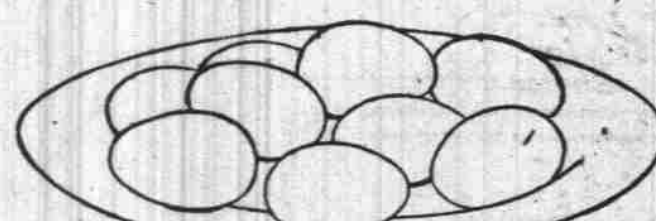
