A permanent summer Bible school under the direction of the Moody Bible Institute of Chicago has been established for the Portland area.

The religious speakers for the closing day of the Chautauque, July 25, will be furnished by the Moody institute people, but the institute will not open officially until July 26.

This institution is supporting Bible conferences this year at Mount Hermon, Cal.; Ashland and Gladstone, Or., and Vancouver, B. C.

The Moody institute at Chicago enrolled over 2300 students last year. Over 8000 more are in the correspondence department.
