LACK OF CARE IN HANDLING MEATS CAUSES HEAVY LOSSES

Lack of suitable care in the handling of country killed meats by transportation interests is causing the loss of not only many thousands of dollars annually at Portland alone, but is depriving consumers of much meat that is finally sent to the crematorium.

Previous to the time that the express companies consolidated into one huge concern, when conditions were favorable, more care was given the country shipments and therefore losses were not so heavy.

During recent days this lack of attention has caused much of the meat to be delivered in a soiled and rotten condition.

Country shippers are complaining bitterly regarding this condition and an effort will be made to have the Public Service Commission take suitable action.
