

OTTO BETHKE IS SERIOUSLY HURT WHEN AUTO SKIDS

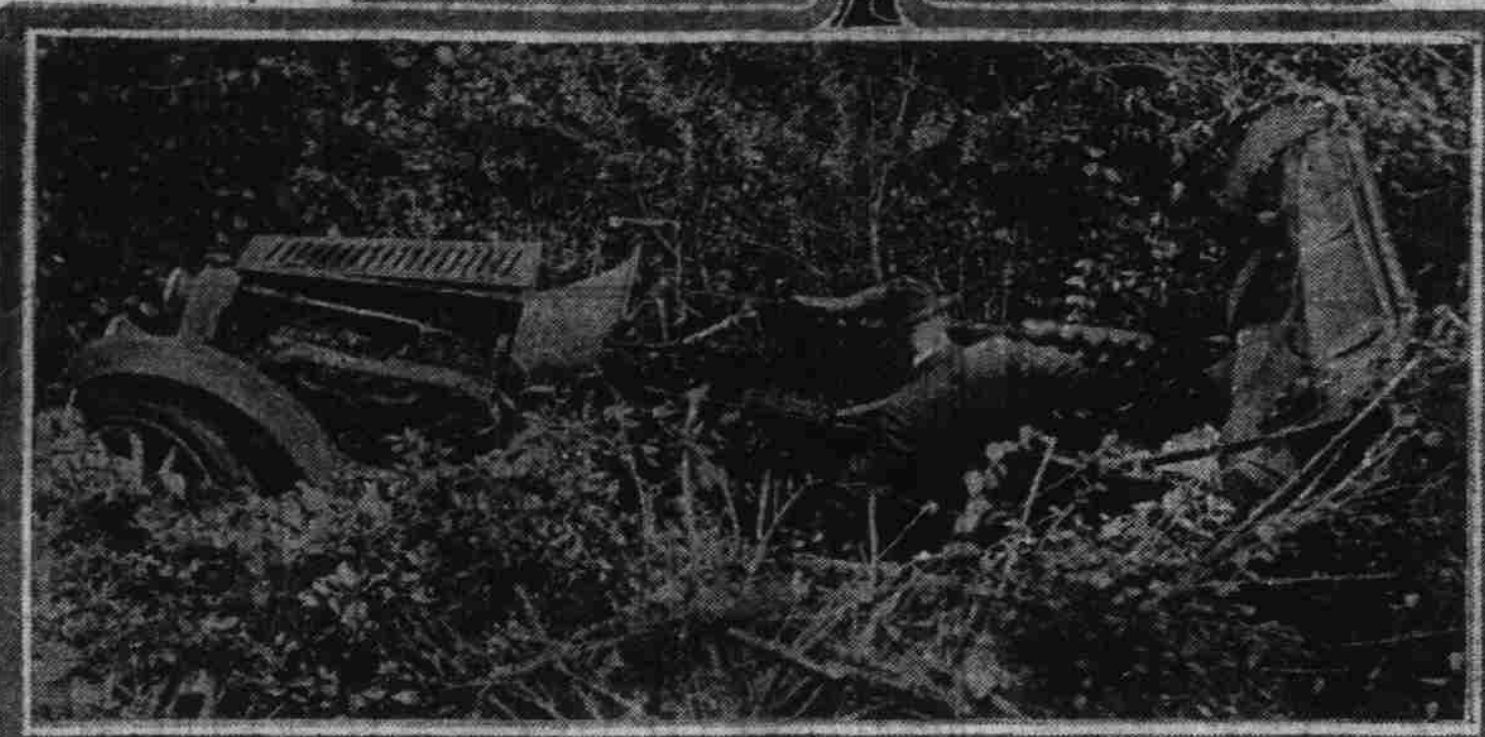
Otto Bethke of Oswego was seriously injured and two companions in his automobile had narrow escapes from death or injury Sunday night when the machine skidded off the Oswego road at Elk Rock, 150 feet inside the Multnomah county line, plunged over the embankment and turned completely over.

Three of Bethke's ribs were broken. His companions were Arthur Anderson and Howe Worthington, both of Oswego. The three men stayed in the car during its mad plunge. The accident was caused by a broken right front wheel spindle.

Apparently the automobile left the pavement while passing a machine approaching in the opposite direction. In attempting to maneuver the car back on the road, the front wheel caught against the edge of the paving and the wheel was torn off. The machine slid 50 feet before going over the edge. Rolling through some small trees, it turned completely over and landed upright in a small gully. The car was wrecked. The wheel causing the accident was not found.

The Elk Rock section of the Oswego road is noted for its dangerous turns, and a fence was put up on these curves to prevent accidents. Bethke was driving along a straight stretch of road toward Portland, and but for the defective spindle the accident would not have occurred, it is said.

Motorcycle Cop Hits Former City Fireman

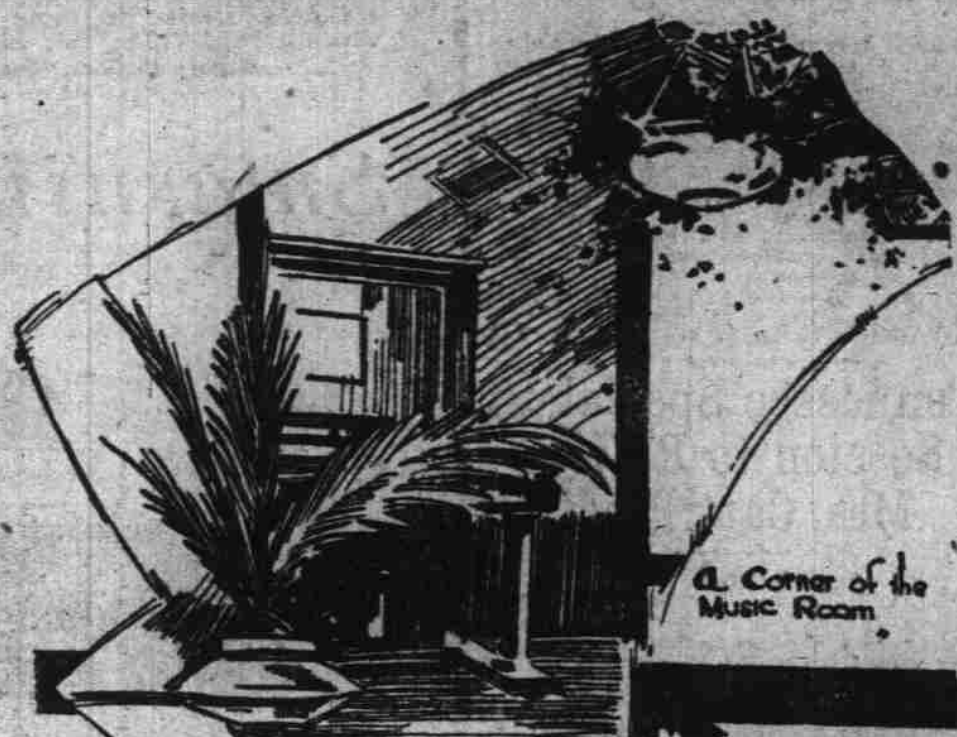
While speeding away from headquarters on an emergency call, Motorcycle Officer Case struck a car driven by A.

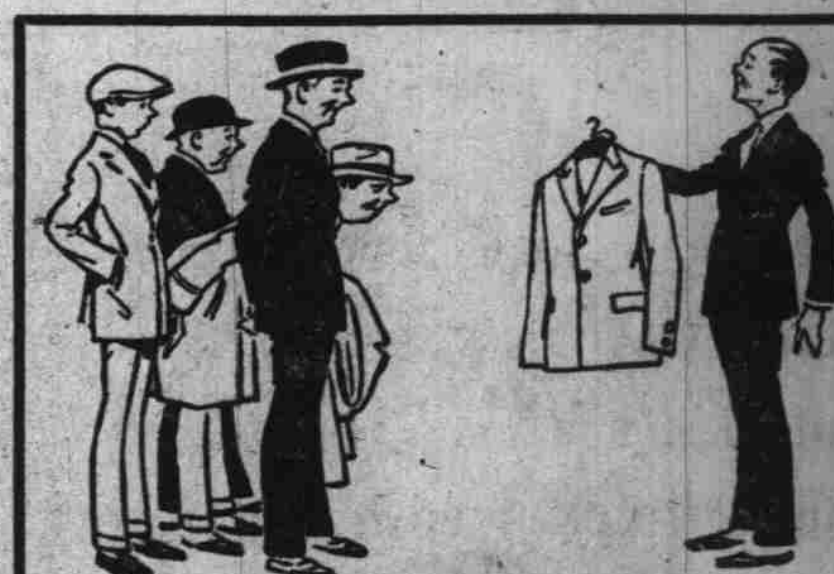
