

WARNING SENT TO COURT REGARDING COMMITMENT LAW

Salem, July 22.—Hereafter patients committed to the state school for feeble minded by county courts and brought to the institution before the superintendent has notified the court of his readiness to accommodate additional patients, will be returned immediately to the county from which committed at the county's expense.

This is the warning note sent to C. R. Wade, county judge of Coos county, by R. B. Goodin, secretary of the state board of control, in advising him of the acceptance of R. H. Huffman, delivered to the school July 16 "without warrant of law," and cautioning the judge against a repetition of this action.

Both the board of control and the superintendent of the state school for feeble-minded are using every effort to give the best service possible under the circumstances, the letter to Judge Wade states, adding that it is unfair for any judge to take undue advantage of conditions for which the officials are not responsible.

A letter being forwarded to every county judge in the state calls attention to the state law which requires that notice of readiness to accommodate additional patients must be given by the superintendent.

By Ed Sten, Reedport, water from an unnamed stream for domestic purposes in Douglas county.

The justice denies that he ordered Schwartz taken to Oregon, it is stated.

Oregon Elements Are to Advertise State's Products

Salem, July 24.—California having monopolized the sun in advertising its products, Oregon growers will resort to the elements which make for superiority in the berries and fruits of this state. Products packed by the Oregon Growers' Cooperative association will be placed on the market under the label of "Midland." Dried and canned fruits packed by the association will be marketed under the name of "Midland," while other products will be labeled "True West." All three names are being registered.

Dorris, California, Wiped Out by Fire

Klamath Falls, Or., July 22.—The business section of the little town of Dorris, Cal., 25 miles south of here, was wiped out by fire Wednesday. The blaze originated in a garage and spread to a creamery, drug store and two hotels, destroying them. All other buildings were damaged.
