

CALIFORNIA STRONG FOR COX, ASSERTS IRVING ACKERMAN

Governor Cox stands an excellent chance of carrying California in November, according to Irving Ackerman, according to Irving Ackerman of San Francisco, one of the Democratic electors chosen in that state when Woodrow Wilson was re-elected to the presidency four years ago.

"Cox is an ideal candidate," said Ackerman, "and especially popular with the labor vote in San Francisco. He has a strong personality and is a good vote getter. I believe he will carry California in the November election. Senator Hiram Johnson, a dominant factor in California politics, is apathetic in his support of Harding and so far in the campaign has not taken the stump against Cox."

Ackerman is senior member of the firm of Ackerman & Harris, owners of the Hippodrome theatre. He arrived Wednesday from San Francisco and will leave tonight for Yakima, Wash., to prepare for the opening of Loew's State theatre at that place on August 25. The building was recently completed for Fred Mercer of Yakima and has been leased by the Hippodrome management for a 20-year period.

Ackerman will be accompanied north by W. W. Ely, manager of the local Hippodrome theatre, and Frank Coffinberry, formerly manager of the Orpheum, who will take charge of the Yakima theatre. The party will also visit Seattle and Spokane and will return to Portland next week. Ackerman & Harris control the 35

theatres on the Low circuit west of Chicago. Ten new theatres are being built in this territory and six of these will be opened September 15. Ackerman stated that there is no immediate prospect for the erection of a new Hippodrome theatre in Portland.

Coos Tide Land Is to Be Sold

Salem, Or., Aug. 12.—Based on reports made by G. G. Brown, secretary of the state land board, and Joe McAllister of the state engineer's office the state land board Wednesday decided to advertise for sale 17,311 acres of tideland near North Bend in Coos county. The character of this land had been questioned by abutting property owners but the state officials decided that it was tideland and subject to sale by the state. The board also ordered McAllister to investigate the Whittaker lake and Fairview lake in Multnomah county with a view to fixing a value on the approximately 320 acres of land contained therein. It is proposed by the Multnomah county drainage district No. 1 to drain these lakes if the state will agree to sell the land and reimburse the district for expense of reclaiming the same.

Advisory Board Is Named to Advance City Park Interest

An advisory park board has been named by President J. C. Ainsworth of the city planning commission, with the approval of Commissioner S. C. Pier, in charge of the park bureau of the city. The members of the new board will be W. B. Ayer, S. Benson, C. C. Colt, Henry L. Corbett, Marshall N. Dana, W. M. Ladd, F. L. Shull, Fred H. Strong and J. B. Yeon. Ex-officio members will be J. C. Ainsworth, S. C. Pier, C. P. Keyser and C. H. Cheney.

The purpose of this board is to see what can be done to increase the park, boulevard and recreation facilities of all parts of the city and to cooperate with the park bureau in an advisory capacity.

The first meeting of the board was held Wednesday afternoon at the United States National bank, with Ainsworth presiding. On behalf of the city planning commission, he pointed out that from the preliminary observations of this body, it is evident that Portland is losing its opportunities to secure an adequate boulevard, park and recreation system, such as a growing city must have, and that a strong board of business men must take a more active interest.

Frank Ferree Held On Serious Charge

Frank Ferree, 40 years old, is being held in the city jail in default of \$1000 bail pending action by the grand jury on charges that he attacked little girls in the basement of an east side restaurant where he had been employed. Acting Municipal Judge Deich arraigned Ferree, but he waived examination and was ordered held. Two 8-year-old girls complained of the man.

Constable Freed of Charge of Violating U.S. Prohibition Law

For nearly two hours the government presented evidence of illicit possession of intoxicating liquor against Frank E. Lowe, constable at Milwaukie, Clackamas county, but failed to stay a dismissal of the charge by United States Commissioner Drake.

Lowe was accused by federal revenue agents of having in his possession 15 gallons of rice whiskey, manufactured by one of Lowe's Chinese tenants. Lowe denied knowledge of the presence of the liquor in his garage.

That the case was a "frame-up" in the political feud that would unsettle W. J. Wilson as sheriff of Clackamas county, was the charge made by Deputy Sheriff Long, Clackamas county speed officer, who was a witness in Lowe's behalf.

Skiff Laden With Scrap Iron Sinks; One Man Drowned

Sinking of a skiff laden with scrap iron late Wednesday afternoon caused the death in the Willamette river of C. Helff, 190 Cook avenue. The accident occurred off the Coast Shipbuilding plant at the foot of Gibbs street. J. McCreary, 370 Second street, an occupant of the boat with Helff, swam ashore.

Helff's body was recovered within 20 minutes by employees of the Coast company and officers of the harbor patrol worked over the body for 45 minutes with a pulmotor, but without success. Helff and McCreary had been grasping for scrap on the bottom of the river. They overloaded the boat and she sank. Helff was unable to swim.

Fire in Garbage Can Of the Platt Building

Fire, originating by spontaneous combustion in a garbage can in the basement of the Platt building, 127 West Park street near Washington street, caused the fire department to be called out at 12:15 p. m. Thursday. Smoke pouring from the basement caused a large crowd to collect, which the police had some difficulty in holding back. There was no damage, according to the fire marshal.

Assault and Battery Charged
Oregon City, Aug. 12.—Assault and battery charges were made by C. A. Stewart Wednesday against Emory Reames of Clackamas Heights, and the latter was arrested and will be given a hearing Thursday.

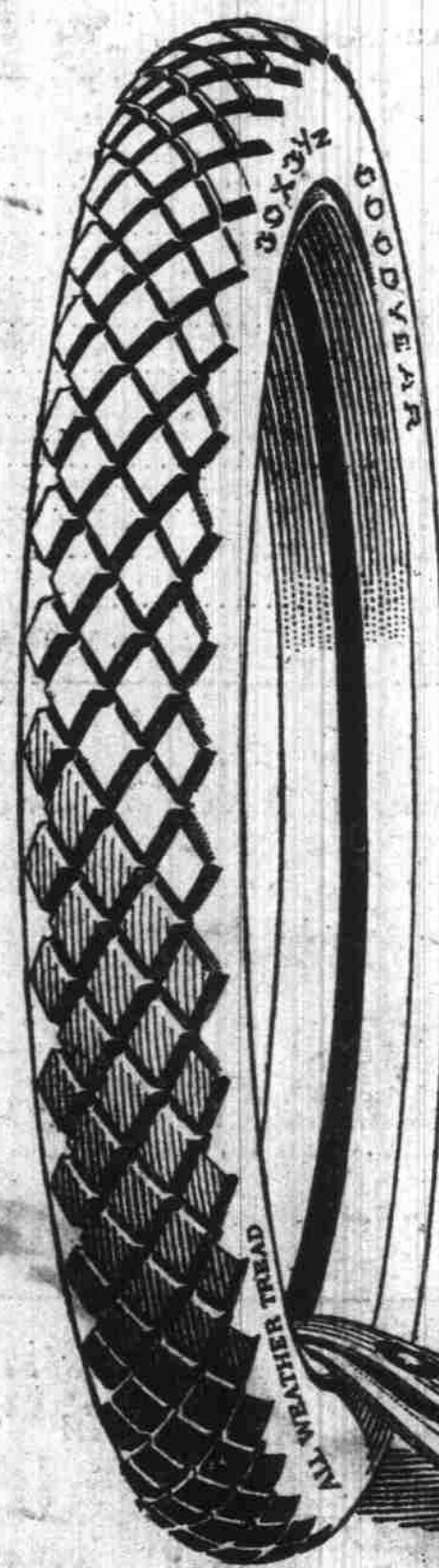
