

VEAL CONTINUES HIGH TO CONSUMER

The price of veal, despite the lower figures in the wholesale market, is today higher for the actual meat than during any previous time in Portland. This is due to the fact that the hides are today selling for only 25c a pound while during the war they sold up to 90c a pound.

Butchers complain that they are unable to get rid of the cheaper cuts of veal—such as steve—even at very low prices—and for that reason are compelled to charge a stiff value for the chops.

Mutton, lamb and beef is getting cheaper in the markets but the hot weather is interfering with appetites.

Cooking fats continue to show a lower price range and further declines are expected.

There is plenty of salmon on the market selling at moderate prices.

The recent advance in butter has forced additional buying of oleomargarine as a substitute.

Good eggs are scarce and for that reason prices are higher.

Consumers in buying light weight fowls demand lower prices than what are being charged for heavier weights because retailers buy such stock cheaper at wholesale.
