127 Predatory Animals Killed—Fifteen men in the month of July killed 127 predatory animals in Oregon, the report of Stanley S. Jewett of the United States biological survey shows. Of these two were bear, 12 bobcats, 111 coyotes and two wolves. During the month the bears were reported to have killed about 10 pure bred sheep and seven pure bred bucks, the coyotes are said to have killed 11 sheep out of a band of 75 in Benton county, and 40 kids and 15 or 20 goats were killed in Tillamook county since March 1.

Whooping Cough at Baby Home—Nine cases of whooping cough among the infants of Waverly baby home resulted in the quarantining of that institution by the city health bureau. Dr. John Abele, acting health officer, closed the home, as far as admission of further cases was concerned, Thursday afternoon. Drs. Elderback and Patrick are attending the cases at the home and Dr. Abele's order followed a consultation with these physicians.
