ATTORNEY FEE OF \$17,500 IS ASKED IN ROELFS ESTATE

Remembrance of one of the most famous cases in the local courts in the determination of heirs was refreshed Monday, when C. T. Haas, attorney, filed a petition asking the probate department of the Multnomah county circuit court to fix \$17,500 as his fee for services to the estate of Mrs. Mary Roelfs, who died in Portland in 1912.

The Rev. E. P. Murphy and Joseph Woerdle, executors, join in the petition and state that the claim is just and reasonable because of the extraordinary services performed by Haas.

Haas says his services extended from March 27, 1912, to July 20, 1920, and that he has received \$6125 on account. The total value of the Roelfs estate was given by T. F. Noonan, J. T. O'Neill and Joseph Sherlock on April 12, 1912, as \$73,577.56.

Mrs. Roelfs, who was in the eighties when she died, had been married three times and was separated from her third husband. In her will she left him a merely nominal amount and provided that one half of her property was to go to the brothers and sisters of her second husband and the remainder was to be divided share and share alike between her own cousins, whom she did not know, but she left instructions to have a certain man in New York interrogated as to who they were.

The outcome was long drawn out litigation, certain points being carried to the state supreme court, and the passage of an act by the state legislature to determine points as to heirship through the lineage of cousins. Eventually there were 159 claimants as cousins of various degrees removed.
