JONES ADVANCED; SEATTLE LOSES ITS JURISDICTION

Lieutenant Harold C. Jones has been advanced to the position of agent of the sea service bureau and the local office separated from the Seattle office. The Portland office now becomes a full agency instead of a sub-agency under the jurisdiction of Seattle.

Captain J. Howard Payne, formerly Seattle agent, has been advanced to assistant director with authority over the entire coast. This order was effective October 11. Lieutenant Jones will retain the same offices and same staff as under the old ruling.

For the enlisting of sea service men the bureau was opened in Portland in August, 1918. It was designated as a sub-agency and the commanding reportorial agents had been diverted to the advancement of Captain Payne to the position of assistant director with authority covering the entire coast the local office was immediately placed on an account of the position the port holds in the maritime world.

The volume of grain exports from Portland during the last months of the last fiscal year and the first three months of the new season has been heavier than all coast ports and the service agents had been called upon to furnish an exceptional number of men. In addition, a large number of recruits have been signed up for the training station and for service on board the training ships.
