THE MARKET BASKET

By Hyman H. Cohen. Considering the great declines and the low prices effective in the raw coffee market, there has been no corresponding decline noted in the price of coffee to the consumer.

Here and there retailers are selling coffee about 10c per pound below the extreme point reached, but generally speaking there has been little change.

The retailer is not to blame for this because the wholesale price has not reflected the lowered raw coffee market. It appears that the time has arrived when this should be done as wholesalers generally were not at all slow about hoisting the price of the roasted product in a day or so after raw coffee advanced.

Coffee has always been considered a source of good profit to the retailer and some of them have gone the wholehearted one better in reducing values. Were this not the case the reduction to the consumer would be less.

The following prices ruled generally in retail shops for good quality coffee values are fractionally higher than factory stuff, fractionally lower.

MARKET IS STRONG IN SPITE OF STRIKE

By Broadan Wall. New York, Oct. 23. - Stocks held relatively firm Friday in the face of an advance in the call money rate to 10 per cent and no change for the better in the labor situation in England.

Price changes were irregular but the close was steady with many issues showing gains ranging from a fraction to a full point. The resistance shown by the general market for unfavorable news was considered another illustration of the strong technical position of shares in general.

Irregularly characterizes the early trading. An effort was made to use Judge Gray's utterances on the prospect of lower prices in general as an excuse for offering shares in the second hour of business, but the professionals were unsuccessful in inducing offerings.

The general list continued strong in the early afternoon and gave every indication of a resumption of the upward movement when the call money rate began advancing.
