

LEAGUE AGAINST PARTY'S POLICIES, ASSERTS HARDING

Candidate Quotes Thomas Jefferson and Grover Cleveland Regarding Entangling Alliances.

Marion, Ohio, Oct. 23.—(U. P.)—In a double-barreled attack on the League of Nations today, Senator Warren G. Harding, in two statements, charged that the Paris covenant violates the principles of the Democratic party and that all Europe clearly understands that it commits America to armed support of the great powers whenever attacked from without.

One statement was issued on the ninety-seventh anniversary death of Thomas Jefferson and the other regarding the recent dispute between President Wilson and Senator Spencer of Missouri over the meaning of the league covenant. Senator Harding put in a quiet day at home sitting for a sculptor most of the afternoon.

"Clearly Europe understands that which we are coming to know: That the league as written commits America to the armed support of the four great powers in maintaining the integrity of their enlarged dominions whenever attacked from without," Senator Harding said in his statement on the Wilson-Spencer controversy which the Missouri senator quoted Wilson as promising the aid of American arms to Rumania if necessary.

"That is why America will vote its unalterable hostility to Article X. When that is done we may seek a new understanding; one which will leave us unmortgaged to Europe and the Orient."

In his statement on Jefferson's anniversary, Harding quoted utterances of the sage of Monticello, of President Grover Cleveland and of President Wilson, himself, all warning against entangling alliances.

Old Fire Marshal Coming to Campaign For the 3-Mill Tax

Jay Stevens, former fire marshal of Portland, now in charge of fire prevention work throughout the United States for the national board of fire underwriters, is scheduled to arrive in Portland Monday morning from the East to spend a week campaigning in favor of the 3-mill tax which the city council has requested the voters to re-authorize for next year.

According to a letter received by Commissioner Bigelow Saturday, Stevens considered the success of this measure so vital to fire prevention work that he postponed fire prevention campaigns in the East to lend his aid to the Portland campaign.

Mailed Fist Alone Can Control Reds Says Frenchman

Paris, Oct. 23.—(U. P.)—General Guibert, head of the French military mission to Russia, who has just returned from Moscow, declared in an interview tonight that nothing could be expected from internal action and that the only hope of overthrowing the soviets was military action by the allies.

"Only military action by the allies can break down the soviets," he said. "Unless this is done, the Bolsheviks will prolong their reign of terror despite misery, disorder and lack of production. The soviets can prolong their power indefinitely through forcible recruiting for the Red army."

President to Issue Campaign Message Dealing With League

Washington, Oct. 23.—President Wilson will take part in the windup week of the presidential campaign through messages. He will make public his views on the League of Nations, particularly those phases of it which have been receiving so much discussion of late.

At a rally of District of Columbia Democrats next Tuesday evening, to take place in the Masonic Temple, the president will issue his first message. "Undoubtedly we will have a message from the president to submit to the voters of the country," declared John H. Colpoys, secretary of the district Democratic committee.

On Wednesday, Hamilton Holt, editor of the Independent of New York, and other pro-league Republicans will be given audiences by the president and authorized to speak for him.

SUGAR MEN ARE WARNED BY U. S.

Federal Prosecution for Merchants Who Try to Boost Prices Again.

Merchants who advance the price of sugar on hand, in keeping with the new advance made by refiners will subject themselves to federal prosecution, according to information received Saturday afternoon by Assistant United States Attorney Hall S. Lusk from Washington, D. C.

"The department adheres to the position that a reasonable profit over the actual cost is the basis which the Lever act requires," reads the message. "However, dealers may average their cost of sugar." Lusk said the last sentence means that any merchant who recently lost money during the decline would be allowed to "average" the cost and sell at an advance, but all merchants who had no stock on hand, in anticipation of the price decline, will not be allowed to advance the price until the new shipment arrives.

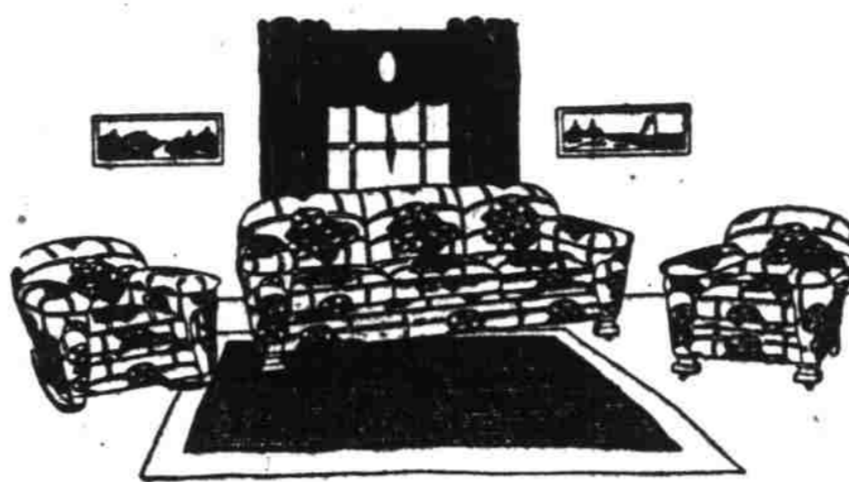
