

M'ARTHUR IS A REACTIONARY SAYS RAIL MAN

Congressman From Third District
Voted With Brokers on Farm
Loan Bill, Avers Cummins.

T. J. Cummins, general chairman of the clerks of the O-W. R. & N. system, contends that Congressman C. M. McArthur "can scarcely hope to be the choice of the voters of the Third congressional district for a fourth term, because of the reactionary trend of his voting record in congress."

"The Third district is strongly Progressive in its tendencies," says Cummins, "and it is inconceivable to me that the voters of this district should again return Mr. McArthur. If they are aware of his pronounced reactionary trend as exhibited in his voting record, Mr. McArthur has with praiseworthy consistency always voted against progressive measures, whenever opportunity presented itself."

OPPOSED FARM LOAN
"An illustration of the situation which developed in regard to the federal farm loan system late in 1917. The various Liberty loan drives had monopolized credit to such an extent that the sale of farm loan bonds was very slow, and the position of the farmers imperiled."

"In order to grant federal relief, especially in view of the fact that at that time the world was in dire need of foodstuffs, a bill was introduced authorizing the purchase by the government of \$100,000,000 worth of farm loan bonds annually for two years. This was in line with the general government policy of the time extending credit to war industries."

"In the senate, Senator Weeks of Massachusetts, himself an investment broker and anxious to keep the farm loan business in the hands of brokers, offered two amendments to the bill. The first would have made this money not available for renewals; that is, the credit could be extended only on original loans."

"The grower who wished to have a renewal could not have had the government offered. The second amendment would have made the money available for only one year. While not absolutely destroying the force of the relief bill, it is obvious that the amendments would seriously have impaired its helpfulness to the farmers. In the house, the Weeks amendments failed of passage by a vote of 217 to 20."

VOTERS WITH BROKERS
"Obviously a vote in favor of the amendments was a vote against the farmers, against the national need of the hour, and in favor of the money brokers as represented by Senator Weeks. There could be little question how the Third district of Oregon would have voted on a referendum. Yet the representative of the Third district in congress voted for the brokers."

"Of course I do not think Mr. McArthur maliciously intended to do evil rather than good. His vote is simply illustrative of his hopeless prejudice in favor of special interests. That is why I do not believe the people of this district will return Mr. McArthur. His mental trend is contrary to that of most of the voters in this district."

VOTERS ASKED TO WRITE IN
F. C. McDUGAL FOR JUDGE
Opponents of the candidacy of Richard Deich for election as judge of the district court, department 2, are urging the voters of the city and county to write in the name of F. C. McDugal. The Rev. A. M. Abbott of 195 East Twelfth street and others opposed to Deich, who are banded into an association known as the Friends of Justice, have issued an appeal to the voters asking them to write McDugal's name on the ballot. The appeal says:

"Your attention is hereby called to the record which has been made by one Richard Deich, who has been occupying the position as deputy district attorney at the municipal court for some time past and has served as municipal judge in the absence of Judge Rossmann at times and who now is a candidate for the high and important office as judge of the district court, department No. 2,

on the Republican ticket. There are doubtless some things about this man's record which have been practiced by him while acting for the public in the above named positions which the voting constituency does not understand, also which those in high authority who have stood back of him, having placed and maintained him in the aforesaid positions, have not understood.

"First, he assumes to be something which he is not and which has never been justified by any code of jurisprudence. His arrogance is simply stifling to the better nature of humanity. Numerous cases can be cited which have been handled by him while acting in the above named positions, where the innocent have been made to suffer because of his hasty and arrogant methods of handling the affairs of mankind. He simply jumps at conclusions in the most obnoxious, obdurate and arrogant manner, and thus frequently the innocent

have been made to suffer under his administration as deputy district attorney and acting police judge.

"If there is any place above another among the affairs of mankind where great coolness of temperament, great deliberation as to degree of righteousness and justice involved and where great wisdom is to be displayed, in behalf of the constituency who are being served, it is certainly upon the throne of justice. This appeal to the ballot box, therefore, is a protest against Deich's efficiency and competency as a judge; in other words, we, the Friends of Justice, hereby contest his qualification and fitness to fill the high and important position of district judge of Multnomah county, as he possesses none of the essential qualities above mentioned."

"Owing to the fact that the majority of the attorneys of the city believe Deich's record in the municipal court

is a failure, and the consensus of opinion among attorneys is that he is not qualified to fill the office of district judge, does it not seem that the public made a mistake in giving Deich the nomination for said office.

"Therefore, this appeal is made to the churches, the citizens, the housewives, the business men of the city and county, to scratch Deich's name and to write in the name of F. C. McDugal on the ballot for judge of the district court, department No. 2, and give McDugal an overwhelming majority."
