

"Big Three" Show Steady Grid Decline

By Henry L. Farrell NEW YORK, Oct. 30.—(U. P.)—Decline of the "Big Three" as a national football power becomes more and more pronounced with each succeeding year.

Since the "open game" found its way into the books and became adopted generally by colleges all over the nation, Yale, Harvard and Princeton have been finding their places on the football field taken by small colleges unheard of a decade back.

This revolution has reached such a point that the "Big Three" in recent years can almost be ignored when it comes to picking the Eastern champions or the national leaders.
