

PEOPLE APPROVE GOVERNOR'S AIDES, RETURNS INDICATE

Olcott's Appointees, Who Sought Re-election, Easily Returned; Not One Official Is Beaten.

Salem, Nov. 6.—That the appointments made by Governor Olcott since his elevation to the executive chair have struck a popular chord throughout the state is indicated in a glance at the returns from Tuesday's election. In 12 instances in which the governor's appointees were up for re-election they have been returned, in most cases by handsome majorities, and in not a single instance was an appointee of the present state administration turned down by vote of the people at the general election.

George M. Brown, named to a position on the supreme bench to succeed A. S. Bennett, resigned, has been elected to the bench by a vote that was surprising to even his most optimistic friends, inasmuch as a vote for the justice required the writing in of the name.

VAN WINKLE RETURNED

I. H. Van Winkle, named to succeed Brown as attorney general, has been returned by a sizable plurality over O. P. Coshaw, Democrat, of Roseburg and J. O. Bailey, Republican, of Portland, again indicating the popularity of the governor's choice for this position.

Sam A. Koser, elevated to the position of secretary of state by the governor, after being chosen by the Republicans as their nominee at the May primaries, has been accorded one of the largest popular votes given to any candidate on the state ticket.

JUDGES SUCCESSFUL

John McCourt, named by the governor to fill a vacancy on the Multnomah county circuit bench; Martin W. Hawkins, named to a position as district judge of Multnomah county, and Jacob Kanzler, appointed judge of the newly created court of domestic relations for Multnomah county, have all been returned to the positions to which they were appointed.

Other appointees up for election at Tuesday's balloting who were returned by popular vote of the people include J. M. Batchelder, circuit judge for Lake county; Robert W. Sawyer, county judge for Deschutes county; D. J. Stewart, county judge for Douglas county; J. M. King, county judge for Jefferson county; C. B. McCluskey, district attorney for Lincoln county, and George A. Sizemore, district attorney for Harney county.

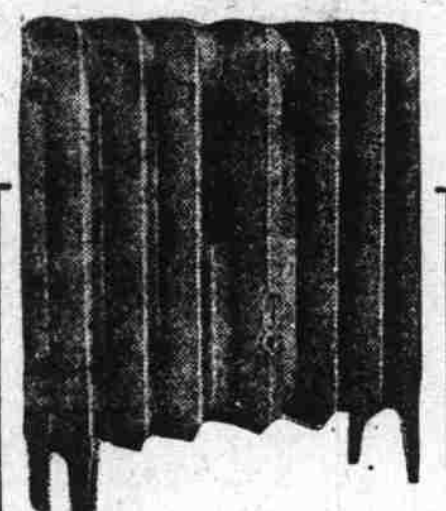
The funeral services were held at Turner, conducted by the Rev. Townsend, who was pastor of the Presbyterian church of Turner for a number of years, where Mrs. Cornelius was an active worker, and interment was at the Masonic Twin Oak cemetery. Turner business houses were closed.

Mrs. Cornelius was a teacher of prominence in the early days, and her home was a hospitable home, where students, teachers, speakers, ministers, relatives and friends were always welcome. She served for a number of years as superintendent of the Presbyterian school, secretary of the Woman's Missionary society and was active in the Eastern Star.

3 Timber Workers Hurt in Car Smash

Chehalis, Wash., Nov. 6.—Jack Dolan and W. Parson, lumbermen in the M. T. O'Connell lumber camp near Winlock, were seriously and possibly fatally injured when the car in which they were riding was struck by two runaway cars, throwing them to the ground. Although a number of other men were endangered, A. Winters saw the cars coming, yelled to them and helped some of them get off. The two injured were slow in getting away. Dolan suffered a broken leg, and the skulls of both were fractured. Winters' heel was crushed and his elbow dislocated from the jump. None of the others was injured.

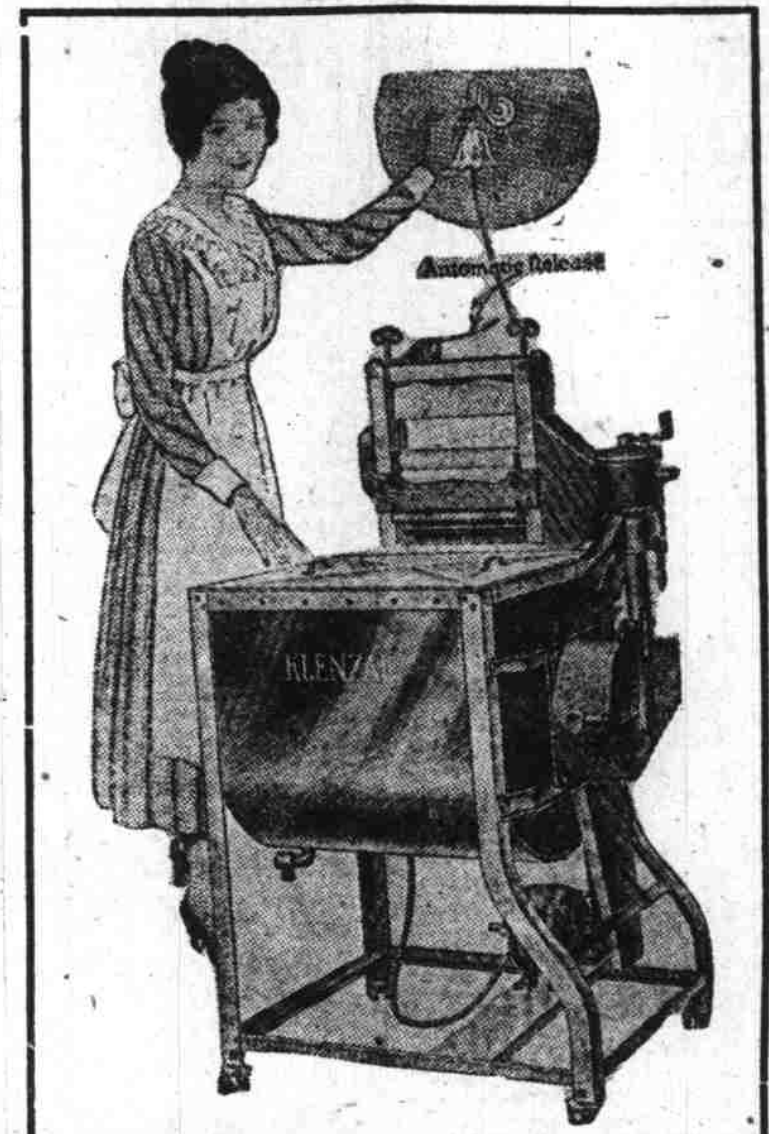
