

## LINN COUNTY'S FUNDS DEPLETED

Albany, Or., Nov. 11.—Four county funds have been so depleted that banks are refusing to cash warrants drawn upon them and a policy of retrenchment has been adopted by the county officials. The funds affected are the market road, general county, general road and bonded road funds.

The county officials say that road construction next year must be materially curbed until the deficit is made up. They lay the shortage to failure of the people to approve the court's request for an additional 3-mill levy with which to continue the road program.
