

EDWARD BAILEY, BANKER OF CURRY COUNTY, ISSUICIDE

Edward A. Bailey, 48, president of the Curry County bank at Gold Hill, shot himself in the mouth with a .32-calibre rifle Sunday afternoon, near Kilekittat and East Eighty-second streets. Death was instantaneous. His suicide is said to have been caused by ill-health.

Bailey has been ill with stomach trouble for five years and during the past month his condition has been serious. He is said to have felt better than usual Sunday and ate a big dinner. A little later he told his family that he felt very ill.

WIFE FEARED SUICIDE

About 2 o'clock he left his home at 715 East Seventy-third street north, carrying his rifle with him. Becoming worried about his absence an hour later, his wife notified the Sunnyside police. She was afraid that her husband had taken his life, she said.

At almost the same time that she called the police they received word that a man had shot and killed himself at East Eighty-second and Kilekittat streets.

Motorcycle Patrolmen Wright and Ingle found Bailey lying beside the road dead. He had placed the end of the rifle barrel in his mouth and pulled the

trigger. Bailey is survived by his widow and five children.

HAD INTERESTS IN CURRY

For several years Bailey has divided his time between Gold Hill and Portland. Most of his business interests were in the smaller town, but because of school advantages for his children he made Portland his home.

His body was removed to the morgue. There will be no inquest, according to Deputy Coroner Goetsch. No funeral arrangements have been made.

Invasion of Insects Follows Burning of Yellow Pine Timber

That light burning increases insect depredations in yellow pine timber by as much as 1000 per cent is the assertion of A. J. Jaenicke, insect specialist of the United States forest service, who has just returned from a field study of the insect invasions and their relation to light fires in the John Day and Burnt river watersheds of the Blue mountains in the Whitman national forest.

This bears out previous experiments made by the bureau of entomology at Ashland, in the Rogue river valley, which showed that fires which do not kill more than 1 per cent of the timber are followed by an increase of timber loss by bark beetles as high as 1000 per cent.

Previous to his Whitman investigations, Jaenicke attended a conference of insect specialists from all parts of the Northwest and of Canada, at Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, at which methods of insect control were discussed.

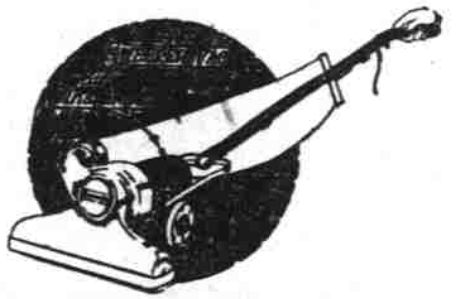
