

NOVEMBER EXPORTS FALL FAR BELOW THOSE OF OCTOBER

Foreign export values for the month of November totaled \$2,223,628. Wheat shipments amounted to 668,944 bushels, valued at \$1,625,000. Flour fell down to 34,123 barrels, valued at \$290,380. Lumber shipment was slow and 11,562,121 feet constituted the month's exports. This was valued at \$398,345. General cargo to the Orient amounted to only \$222,836.

October exports amounted to \$7,526,157, or more than three and one half times the volume of business handled during November, on a working day. This is largely due to the fact that charter rates went up in the air and that exporters are holding off until the decision of the Pacific coast conference, now in session at Seattle.

While the conference decision will have no bearing on the rate to continental ports or the United Kingdom, it is possible the shipping board will be governed by the action of that commercial body.

Eleven vessels sailed from Portland during the month of November. Of this fleet 10 were steamers and one sail. South America called for three; United Kingdom, three; Orient, three; Australia, one; Antwerp, one.

PORT ORDERS TEST CASE INVOLVING BONUS CLAIMS Gus Moser, attorney for the commission of the Port of Portland, was authorized at the meeting Monday to arrange a test case in the matter of claims for the bonuses alleged to be due shipping firms operating in and out of Portland. The right of the port board to grant bonuses will be settled in the courts and future difficulties averted.

LOWER RATES PREDICTED FROM PACIFIC TO ATLANTIC Los Angeles, Nov. 30.—Following the action of several steamship companies in preparing reduced water rates on various commodities, local traffic managers today were predicting a somewhat general reduction in steamship rates from the Pacific to the Atlantic.

Notice of the meeting has been sent to the Portland Chamber of Commerce by H. H. Eby, director of shipping board operations on the Pacific coast. The call for opinions has been sent out by R. A. Dean, special assistant to the chairman.

Section No. 28 has to do with establishment of rail route differentials in favor of freight going to American bottoms. Shipping interests are divided on the subject.
