"Finished before we began," is the startling message received from the committee in charge of the sale of Christmas seals in Dallas by the Oregon Tuberculosis association. The Dallas Woman's club, of which Mrs. H. C. Eakin is president, was in charge of the sale.

Today, December 1, is the date set for the opening of the sale throughout the state and nation, but already many cities and communities have reordered. Stayton high school students, under the leadership of Miss Ella Williams, sold their seals in an hour and immediately ordered more. St. Helens and Oregon City have reordered,

Returns from the Portland mail sale are already flooding the office. One of the first return letters was from Fannie Rood, 615 East Main street, to whom had been sent \$2 worth of seals, a check for \$25 was enclosed. Another early arrival was a letter from Albert Cleveland, who had also been sent \$2 worth of seals. Mr. Cleveland had presented the merits of the association to the other men in his office and a check for \$21 was enclosed, the contributors including Mr. Cleveland, L. R. Henderson, A. J. Brugger, J. H. Roberts and E. Barkus.

Game Commission Makes New Rule On Salmon Trout

Because game and dommercial fishing laws conflict, the state fish and game commission has decided to make 10 inches the minimum length for salmon-trout taken during closed season on game fish, instead of 15 inches as in former years, according to announcement made by the commission Tuesday

afternoon. All game fishing closed Tuesday evening and will be closed until April 1, 1921. This closing order includes trout, bass, crappies, whitefish, catfish and graylings. In former years sloughs of the Willamette river in Multnomah, Columbia, Clatsop and Linn counties were open to catfish angling all year; but they will be closed in the future during the closed season for game fishing.

Game authorities have had trouble in the past in handling the salmon-trout fishing during closed season for game tishing. The game code declares that a salmon trout is a trout until it is 15 inches in length, while the commercial code declares a trout to be a salmon trout after it is 10 inches long.

To avoid duplication the commission has decided upon 10 inches as the game law minimum for salmon trout and will continue this new regulation until standard laws can be drafted.
