

CUMULATIVE KICK FOUND IN CIDER; LICENSE REVOKED

Cider, manufactured in Portland and throughout the state, and a grape product manufactured in California and shipped into Portland, developed as high as one per cent alcohol content each day, according to City Chemist F. L. Kerry's testimony at the hearing of soft drink vendors before the city council this morning.

As a result of the hearing the license of Joe Talich, 262 First street, was revoked. G. B. Goritsan, 414 1/2 Washington, and Goritsan Brothers, 440 Washington, were allowed to continue in business on the understanding that they would eliminate the questionable beverages from their stocks.

ACCUSED GETS CHANCE
C. Johns, 480 Washington street, will be given an opportunity to prove that the wholesaler delivered the intoxicating beverages to him in an objectionable alcoholic state before final action is taken on his license by the council this afternoon.

Officials of the American Soda Works were scheduled to appear before the council at the afternoon session to prove their products non-intoxicating in accordance with the federal prohibition law's requirements.

KICK IS CUMULATIVE
Testimony at the morning hearing developed the fact that many dealers received the beverages into their establishments in a non-alcoholic state, but that in the event the entire contents of the containers was not disposed of within 10 days the beverages would then contain 10 per cent alcohol, or in 20 days an alcoholic content of 20 per cent. Dealers also testified that manufacturers and jobbers were careless in handling containers, thereby frequently delivering to the unsuspecting dealer an apparently harmless beverage with a very liberal alcoholic content.

SIX PER CENT CLAIMED
One police officer stated that a fresh keg of beverage tested in the wholesaler's warehouse showed 6 per cent alcoholic content. As a result of the testimony Commissioners Barbur, Bigelow and Mann said they would summon the wholesalers and manufacturers before the council to determine whether or not they should be put out of business.

"The city should license these wholesalers, so the officers can keep them under their eye, thus providing the council with evidence to put them out of business. In the event they are delivering a prohibitive alcoholic content in their product to the dealers," Commissioner Barbur declared.

British Labor Party Submits Its Irish Policy to Premier

London, Dec. 16.—(U. P.)—The Labor party of Great Britain submitted its Irish peace plans to Premier Lloyd George late today. An immediate truce was urged by a committee appointed after party executives had heard reports from Arthur Henderson and other laborites who investigated Irish conditions a fortnight ago.

The executives, after a long session, met the premier in Downing street at 5:30 this evening.

Laborite observers of conditions in Ireland reported to their colleagues that large numbers of eye witnesses swear the Cork fire was started by auxiliary police—the Black and Tan. Circumstantial evidence bears that out, they declared. They believed the fire was planned to destroy the entire center of the city.

Eugene Prisoner Sets Jail Ablaze; Rescued, Subdued

Eugene, Or., Dec. 16.—Fred Worthington, an ex-soldier, who has been confined in the city jail here for several days on a charge of intoxication, early Thursday morning attempted to destroy the frame building by fire. The offi-

cers, as a mark of consideration, had allowed him the liberty of the small lobby of the jail, containing a small stove. The jail stands a short distance from that part of the city hall in which the fire department is located and at 5:30 o'clock the firemen heard Worthington yelling lustily.

As he had frequently amused himself in this way, they paid no attention to him until a passerby roused them with the report that the jail was burning. A part of one end and a section of the roof was burned before the flames were checked and the prisoner rescued, thor-

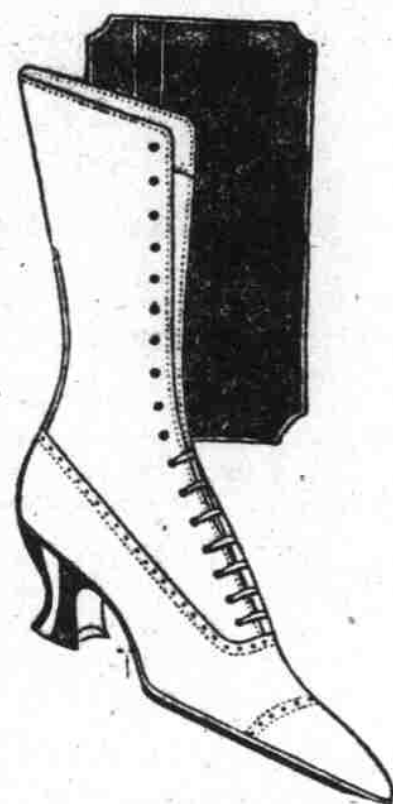

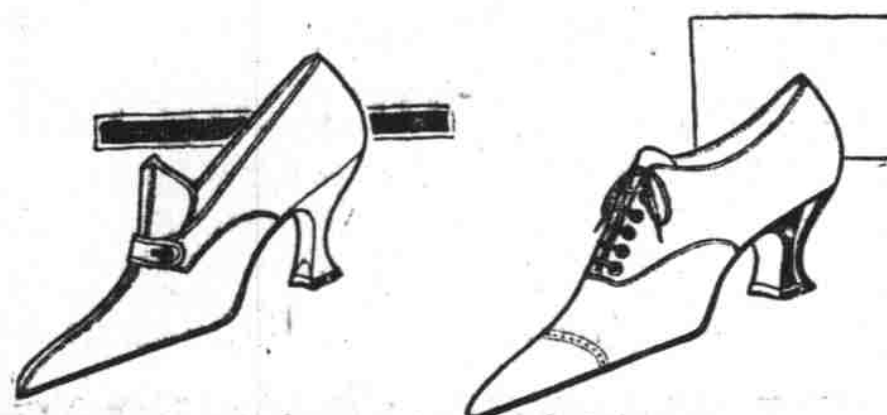

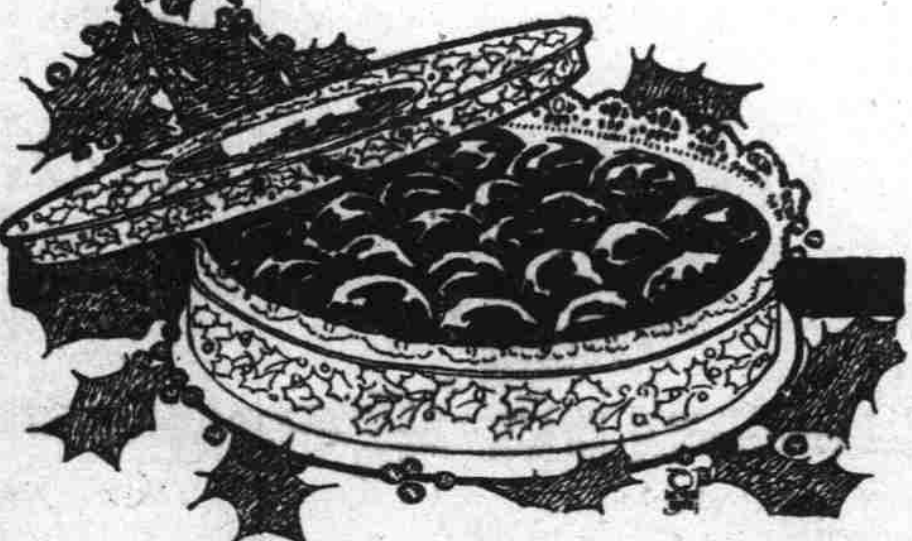
