WEATHER CONDITIONS

The Pacific coast weather is slowly changing, the center of low pressure area is now over the Gulf of St. Lawrence. A shallow depression is central in New Mexico. A crest of high pressure extends from Northwestern Canada to Florida. Precipitation is frequent in the Middle and North Pacific slopes and in parts of Montana, Wyoming, Nebraska and Pennsylvania. Snow is falling in Eastern Oregon and Northern Wyoming. The weather is colder in the central and Eastern states than in the Middle and North Pacific coast to Texas.

Relative humidity at Portland: Yesterday, 72 per cent; today, 70 per cent; tomorrow, 64 per cent.

Barometer at Portland: Yesterday, 30.00 inches; today, 29.99 inches; tomorrow, 30.00 inches.
