

Churches of Portland Begin Week of Prayer Sunday Morning

NATIONAL PRAYER WEEK BEGINS SUNDAY MORNING

Beginning Sunday morning national prayer week will be observed in the churches of Portland. Some pastors will present the theme on Sunday only, while in other churches the recommendation of the national committee will be complied with and special services held each night. Several churches have announced special services for each night next week, and still others will conduct cottage prayer meetings.

A copy of the topics suggested by the national committee for the special services has been mailed every pastor in the city by the Federation of Churches. At the annual meeting last September of the Portland Ministerial association, a motion was carried to observe the first week in January as the week of prayer, in keeping with the custom established in the east several years ago. This week marks the beginning of the spirit of church campaign, which culminates with the Easter Sunday morning service, when large numbers are admitted to membership by all communions.

Dr. McConaughy to Make Addresses on Stewardship Issues

Dr. David G. McConaughy, head of the stewardship department in the Free Presbyterian church of the U. S. A., will be in Portland Wednesday and address three conferences of local stewards and pastors.

At 10:30 a. m. he will meet the clergy of the Portland presbytery at the First Presbyterian church, and at 2:30 o'clock will address a women's mass meeting. A luncheon for the stewardship directors of each Presbyterian church in Portland and Dr. McConaughy has been arranged for 6:30 p. m. at the Y. M. C. A. After the conferences here Dr. McConaughy will travel South, stopping at Eugene on Thursday for a conference with the Willamette presbytery.

In the conferences the necessity of a fixed and methodical system of giving will be emphasized. The Rev. Monroe G. Everett, pastor of the Fourth Presbyterian church, is chairman of the committee on arrangements, as he is chairman of the stewardship committee in this presbytery.

The January meeting of the Portland Ministerial association will be held at 10:30 a. m. Monday in the Y. M. C. A. auditorium. Dr. M. E. Dodd, pastor of the First Baptist church of Shreveport, La., will speak on the general theme, "The Minister and the New Year."

During the coming week a union Baptist conference on Christian stewardship will be held at the White Temple, with sessions daily, except Saturday, from 10:30 a. m. to 2:30 p. m. The speakers are: The Rev. M. E. Dodd, D. D., pastor of the First Baptist church of Shreveport, La.; the Rev. Frederick W. Parr, D. D., pastor of Calvary church of Los Angeles; and the Rev. W. B. Hinson, D. D., pastor of the East Side Baptist church of Portland. At 3 p. m. Sunday there will be the first union mass meeting, when Dr. Parr will speak.

The Rev. Dodd will occupy the pulpit of the White Temple Sunday morning and evening. At the close of the morning service he will administer communion.
