

# OSWEGO DISTRICT IS IN FAVOR OF ANNEXATION PLAN

Residents of the Oswego district, nearly all of them taxpayers, expressed themselves unanimously in favor of annexation to Multnomah county and secession from Clackamas, at a meeting held in Oswego Wednesday night. There were 100 persons present at the meeting and only one voted "no" on the annexation question.

The meeting was held under the auspices of the joint annexation committee and was presided over by the Oswego district member, Sydney B. Vincent. Vincent outlined the plan of the annexationists as to the territory embraced in the seceding area, following this up with explanation that the tax per acre of equal valuation is less in Multnomah than in Clackamas and less on lots in Portland than in Oswego on property of the same distance from the center of the city.

**SCHOOL NEEDS SEEN**  
He also called attention to the fact that outside of the Oswego grammar school, which he termed a splendid institution equal to any similar school in Portland, that the district had absurdly primitive school facilities. He also brought out that it has no grade although right on the environs of Portland. "Multnomah (suburb of Portland), which is just the same distance from Portland as Oswego, has paved highways, fine Bull Run water and excellent schools and they do not pay as much taxes over there as we do here in the Oswego district."

"We would not object to paying taxes to Clackamas if we got adequate return, but we get nothing, never have, and never will, for Oregon City is Clackamas county and the Oregon City clique runs it for the benefit of that town and its three or four great but undertaxed industries, at the expense of us little fellows. I would not assume to say how much we will get at Multnomah's hands, but we will get more than from Clackamas."

**EVERY LITTLE HELPS**  
"That's not saying much," came from the audience. "Anything is more than nothing."

"Annexation to Multnomah may mean eventual absorption into Portland," was contended by the only speaker opposing annexation.

"That would be a piece of wonderful fortune," replied Vincent. "I wish that it were something more than a dream." A storm of hand clapping and stamping of feet met this remark. Several expressed themselves as anxious that a committee of Oswego district taxpayers go to Salem to be heard before the legislative committee and these were assured by President R. C. Stoetzel of the Lake Grove Community club, that such a committee is being arranged.

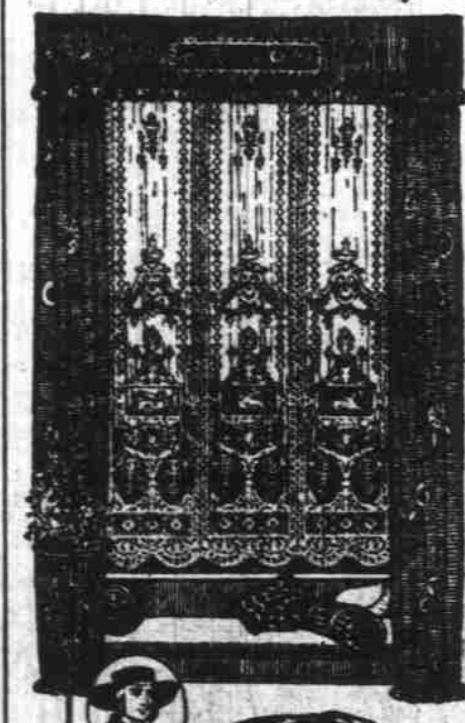

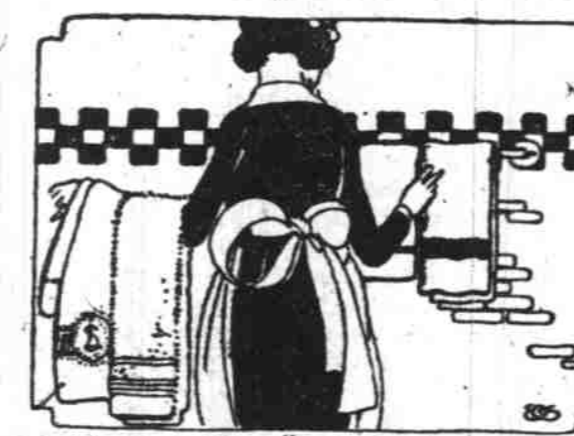
