

GRANDSQUADERS LEAVE FOR GREAT VESSELS IN PORT

To load grain and lumber for foreign ports eight vessels are in the harbor today and all will clear by the end of the month.

Kerr, Gifford & Co. have two vessels in port this morning—the American steamship Mosella and Eastern Ocean.

In the service of the Isthmian line the steamship Steel Inventor is due at Municipal No. 1 this afternoon with general cargo from the East Coast.

The steamship Yalza, North Atlantic and Western Steamship company, shifted to the St. Johns Lumber company this morning.

At Terminal No. 4 the Japanese steamship Anyo Maru, Valparaiso for the Orient, berthed at No. 2 this afternoon.

The total net tonnage of the vessels arriving and working cargo today in the harbor business tonnage is 13,566 tons.

Many Eastern tourists came here on the Creole State, making the journey from Baltimore via the Panama canal.

The Creole State starts across the Pacific February 1.
