

BEST BUTTER IS NOW AT 50 CENTS

Consumers should not pay above 50c a pound today for the very best butter in parchment wrappers, although 1 a pound above this is the charge for supplies in cartons. The 2c drop in the wholesale price during the day took effect immediately and consumers should demand their supplies at the lower price. Sugar prices are 25c a hundred pounds lower in the wholesale trade for the day and some of the downtown markets have already met this price to the consumer. It begins to look as if the recent flurry in the egg market was ill advised and that a drop will soon be forced in value unless weather conditions in the East are too severe. The price here is now made by the weather in New York.
There is an unusual scarcity of comb honey in the retail shops, but a full carload is coming from Eastern Oregon, but this will be the last. The price is higher. The following prices ruled generally in retail shops for good quality. Some values are fractionally higher, inferior stuff fractionally lower:

Eggs—Fresh laid, extra, 90¢ per dozen; extra pullets, 55¢.
Poultry—Chickens, dressed, 50¢ lb.
Fish—Salmon, 20¢ @ 25¢ lb.; halibut, 35¢ lb.; Columbia river smelt, 3 lbs. for 25¢.
