

Senators Take Beavers to 10-6 Defeat

SACRAMENTO, Cal., April 13.—Pitcher Bill Rodgers' Solons caused the defeat of the Mackmen Tuesday, 10 to 6. The loss was the eighth straight suffered by the Mackmen.

Portland hit Pitcher, Faeth, who started on the mound, hard and often in the early innings, but brilliant fielding by the Solon infielders kept the Beavers from the plate until the fifth inning, when the Mackmen crossed the plate four times on four hits, including a double by Cox, a walk and an error.
