By James Allerton Special Correspondent of The Journal New York, April 21.—New York retailers protested vigorously today against the charge of the federal trade commission that retail prices were not only not keeping pace with the downward trend of wholesale prices but were being artificially maintained.

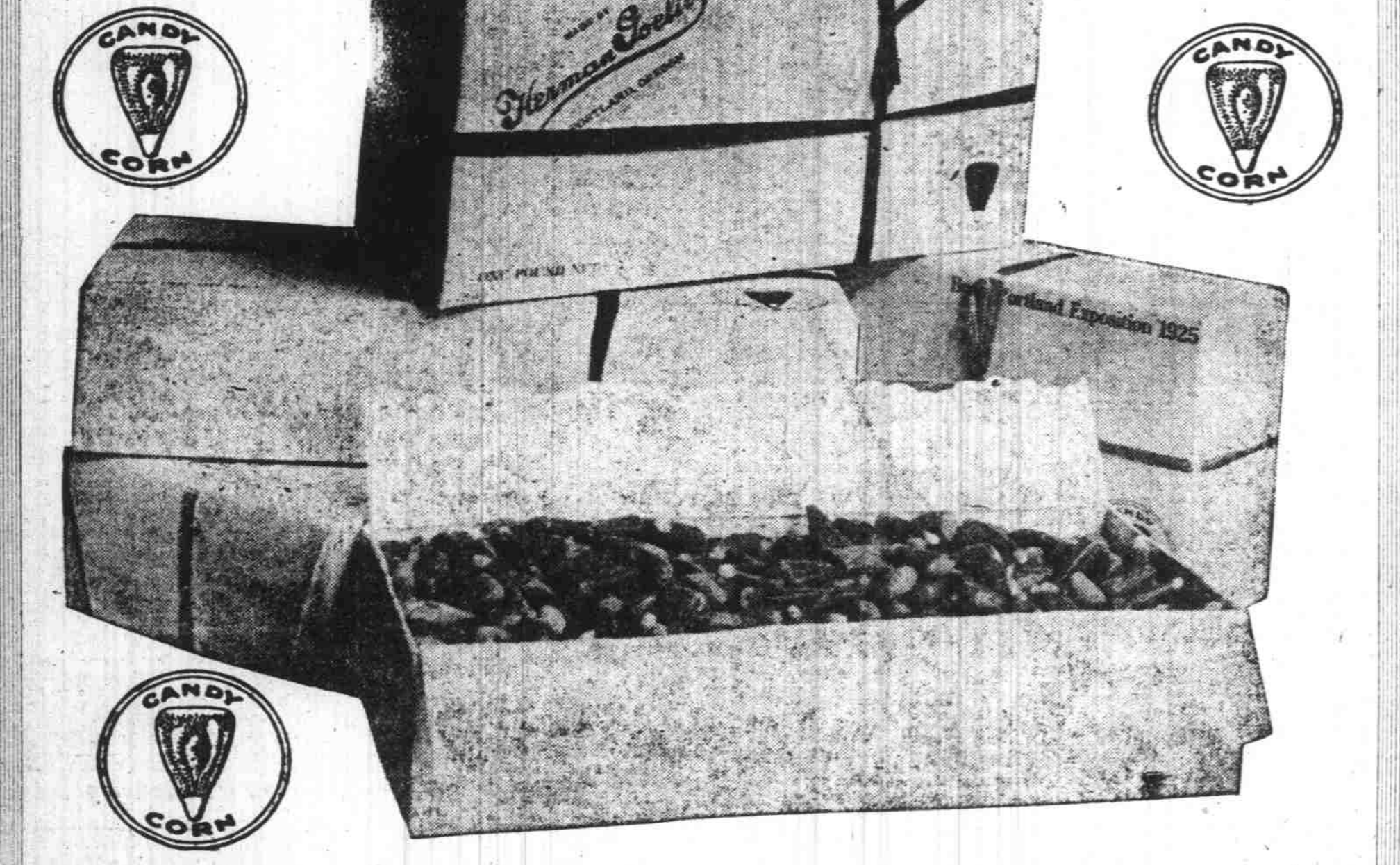
