

Sewer Contract

Is Won by Kelso Contracting Firm

Kelso, Wash., April 22.—Gillman & Leizen of this city were awarded the contract for construction of the sewer project on Allen, Academy and other streets. The contract price is approximately \$2200 and work will begin at once.

The Silver Lake Railway & Lumber company dredge, which has been working in this vicinity, was towed down the Columbia river today to the Clatskanie. The Rogue River Valley Canal company of Medford contemplates the construction of a canal to divert water from the Rogue river to the Medford Irrigation district, which has appropriated for Little Butte project for the irrigation of 283 acres of new land. This construction is under way.

The E. J. Schaffler of this city has secured permit for the appropriation of water from the Rogue river to the Medford Irrigation district for the irrigation of 395 acres of land at an estimated cost of \$25,000.

The Summer Lake Irrigation district has applied to the Federal irrigation securities commission for state guarantee of interest on bonds authorized by the district in the sum of \$260,000. The application states that the interest is guaranteed for five years. The district includes approximately 4000 acres and is located in Lake county.

U. S. REPLIES

The following is the text of the reply of the secretary of state forwarded through the American commissioner at Berlin:

"April 21, 1921.

"This government could not agree to mediate the question of reparation between the United States and Germany. It is too new to act as umpire in its settlement. Impressed, however, with the seriousness of the issues involved as they affect the whole world, the government of the United States feels itself to be deeply concerned with the question of obtaining an early and just solution. This government strongly desires that the peace between the United States and Germany be settled on a basis of justice and equity, and it reiterates its earnest hope that the German government will promptly formulate such proposals as will present a proper basis for discussion."

"Should the German government take into consideration the matter to the attention of the allied governments in a manner acceptable to them in order that negotiations may be speedily resumed."
