One of the largest naturalization hearings held in the federal court since the beginning of the war is set for Thursday morning before Judge C. E. Wolverton, when about 150 persons are expected to apply for admission to American citizenship. About 50 of these will probably be alien enemies, who have been released by Naturalization Examiner W. W. Tomlinson. Nine ex-service men are also on the list. If very many of the cases are complicated the hearing will probably last more than the one day.
