

VANDERLIP COMING BACK TO LECTURE ABOUT RUSSIANS

New York, June 21.—(I. N. S.)—Washington D. Vanderlip, head of the American syndicate which has secured commercial concessions in Russia, will begin a national "campaign of education about Russia," when he arrives in this country tomorrow on board the liner Olympic. The radiogram, which was a reply to the query as to Mr. Vanderlip's future program, follows:

"I intend to go before the real government—the American people—with press articles and lectures. Later I shall go to Washington to talk with members of the administration. I believe that the administration must rise or fall, according to its future attitude regarding Europe, and Russia is the crux of the European situation.

"Secretary of State Hughes and Secretary Hoover are ignorant regarding the truth. They have been misinformed by former prisoners of the revolutionists and by entente propaganda.

ON WRONG SIDE

"The British white book sent to Secretary Hughes should have a black cover with a skull and crossbones. If the contents of this book are true, why did England recognize Russia?"

"Secretary Hughes and Secretary Hoover are always defeated because they are always on the wrong side. I consider victory easy. My biggest job was pushing England over the top. I expect an onslaught of government propaganda from the civic federation and the American chamber of commerce, but the more the merrier. I am armed with the truth, with facts they do not possess.

CONCESSIONS SEVERE

"The syndicate (American syndicate headed by Vanderlip) is not in this for money. My last instructions from the directors were: 'Put over a big thing—peace and reconstruction; concessions are secondary.'

"Everything is going according to schedule. The naval bases, the Murmansk pulpwood concessions and the Kamchatka concessions are secure for all time."

Before leaving London Mr. Vanderlip announced that the soviet government at Moscow had offered the United States two naval bases on the Pacific coast in perpetuity if America will open trade relations with Russia. That explained Mr. Vanderlip's reference to "naval bases."

Denny, Seattle; \$50,000 from the estate of the late governor of Washington, Miles C. Moore; \$75,000 from seven children of the Weyershaeusers; \$115,000 conditional upon obtaining \$250,000 additional, from the general education board of New York city. (This \$250,000 Dr. Penrose states is nearly complete); \$480 from the estate of Miss Julia Whitman, Minnesota; \$950 from the estate of Miss Mary Dickinson, Romeo, Mich.; \$6250 interest paid by the general education board; \$727 miscellaneous.

Declaring that he has been held up in a false position in being touted as head of a movement to establish the Ku Klux Klan in Oregon, Bragg Callaway of Houston, Texas, has issued a flat denial that he is interested in any such movement. Callaway said he came to Portland last year with the Shriners and liked the city so well and made so many friends that he determined to come back on his next vacation.

Callaway is vice president of a manufacturing company at Houston. At the Multnomah hotel he declared that an afternoon paper had devoted much front-page space to his reputed activities, but he said it was without consulting him, and that he is not and has not been identified with the famous Southern organization of secret avengers.

Reports have been current in Portland frequently of late that an organization similar to the Klan is being organized to operate against Asiatics as a protection to American whites.

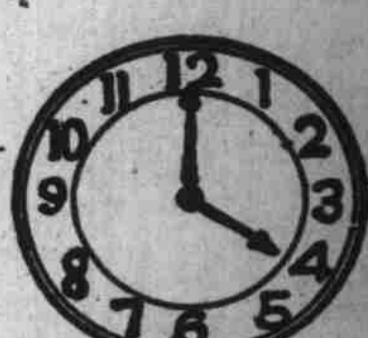
