The celebration of the victory of the Greeks over the Turks at Eskişehir by means of bell ringing, shouting, shooting and parades, such as America held to celebrate the signing of the armistice.

"I confess to pretty deep emotion as I looked at the Boy Scouts and the girls from the orphanages drawn up on the wharf at Constantinople to greet us with songs and flowers. They are just a few of the multiplied thousands whom America is salvaging from the war."

As we were taking 7000 tons of supplies with us from Constantinople we dropped down the Gulf of Ismid 60 miles to Derinje, where our warehouses are located, to take on flour, beans, rice, clothing, knitting machines and other supplies, enough for a month for the Caucasus.
