

CELERY OF FANCY QUALITY OFFERED

Have you had celery for lunch recently? The quality is now at its best and the price is as low as the most economical housewife could wish. There is a very liberal supply now available in the retail shops and it is nice and tender and fresh. If you don't care to purchase a big head of celery, there is the celery heart—the goodly part of the vegetable that is being offered in the leading stores.

Spinach is now at its best for the fall season and most of the retail shops have it on sale at 10c a pound, or sufficient for the average family.

Cabbage is now well in season with enormous heads that are sold. These are being sold at 3 to 3 1/2c a pound.

Lettuce is now coming in fair supply with most dealers asking 10c for the better heads.

Onions are slowly advancing in price. It would pay to purchase your probable needs for a month or so at least.

Potatoes are showing no price change as yet, but the quality is better.

Green peppers will soon be out of season so far as home supplies are concerned. Then prices will advance on the offerings from California and Florida.

Garlic is in abundant supply and the price is the lowest for at least a year.

Radishes are unusually good for this time of the year. The usual price of 5c a bunch prevails and will be offered at 5c a pound for the local stock. It clearly shows the flag end of the season.

Power Site Permit Asked on Creek in Crater Lake Forest

For the development of a 1500 horsepower waterpower site on Anna creek, in the Crater Lake national forest, just south of the national park boundary.

The Fort Klamath Meadows company has made application for a permit from the federal waterpower commission, through the district engineer's office of the U. S. forest service, according to P. H. Dator, district engineer.

The company proposes a flume along the right bank one and one half miles long. The proposed power will be used on 37,000 acres of reclaimed and irrigated land for use as light and power at mills and residences.
