

# LOCAL POST SENDS LARGE DELEGATION TO KANSAS CITY

Oregon will be well represented at the third annual national convention of the American Legion scheduled for Kansas City, Mo., next Monday, Tuesday and

Wednesday, according to an announcement made by State Commander G. Lane Goodell. Commander Goodell and State Adjutant Edward J. Elvers headed a party of legionnaires which left Wednesday morning and this afternoon several more members of the Legion will depart for the East.

Arthur A. Murphy, alternate national committee man from Oregon, will leave for the scene of the convales Thursday morning. Because of the 1-cent-a-mile rate granted by all railroads, the Kansas City convention is expected to establish an attendance record, Oregon being responsible for three times as many as have ever been sent from here to a national affair.

# REV. B. MURPHY MADE ABBOTT OF SAINT BENEDICT

The Rev. Bernard Murphy, O. S. B., who bears the distinction of being the first Portland man to be ordained a

priest in the Catholic church, was elected abbot of Saint Benedict abbey at Mount Angel on Tuesday to succeed Abbot Placidus, deceased.

Abbot Murphy was born in Portland, December 10, 1874, and between 1891 and 1894 attended the public school which stood where the Portland hotel now stands. He also attended the old Saint Michaels' school at Fifth and Mill streets when the following dignitaries were members of the faculty: Bishop O'Day of Seattle; Bishop O'Reilly, former bishop of Baker, Or., and former Archbishop Orth, of Oregon City.

Abbot Murphy's mother was born while her parents were crossing the plains in January, 1847. His father was a native of Boston, Mass., and came to Oregon in 1855. He lived in Portland from 1861 to 1914. When the elder Murphy first came to Portland, Front Street was the only street in the city.

# Chinese Chef Falls Dead at His Work

Chin Moon Yet, Chinese chef of the Oregon hotel, dropped dead Tuesday evening while preparing the menu. Heart trouble was said to be the cause.
