

LAST PLEA TO BE MADE CLATSOP TO STAY IN LEAGUE

If the Clatsop county division determines to secede from the Oregon Dairyman's Cooperative league, the Washington county division is preparing to follow at a mass meeting in Hillsboro next Saturday. If these two divisions go there is little doubt that the Coos-Curry division will join the secessionists and there will be nothing left of the league.

This announcement by A. E. Westcott of Banks, president of the Oregon Dairyman's Cooperative league, brought to a focus the consideration given the league's crisis during a conference between the executive committee of the organization and leaders of the cooperative marketing movement in Oregon. The conference was held in the offices of State Dairy and Food Commissioner C. L. Hawley and continued during the greater part of Sunday afternoon.

TO MAKE LAST APPEAL
In consequence Executive Committee members Baker, Flint and Brugger are in Astoria today, reinforced by Dairy and Food Commissioner Hawley, C. E. Spencer, master of the league, and Dr. Hector MacPherson of Oregon Agricultural College. They will meet with the Clatsop county dairymen and make a last appeal to them to stay in the league.

An analysis made during the Sunday afternoon conference showed that the league's affairs are financially sound, that the number of returning Clatsop members will be greater than those who remain loyal and that the league can continue doing business, meet its obligations and protect its members if the last named remain loyal.

MAY FORFEIT MICH
The Clatsop dairymen, it was said, by violating their contract, probably forfeit amounts due them for unsold product, and lose their interest in substantial depreciation and sinking funds which have accumulated.

Immediately following the Clatsop mass meeting, a meeting of league directors will be held in Portland, to decide whether to go ahead with the whole organization, according to announcement by Westcott.

President Westcott is unable to meet with the Clatsop county dairymen because of a search for his 14-year-old son, who disappeared from the Westcott home at Banks Saturday. The committee which met with the league's executive committee, C. E. Elbridge, manager, and P. H. Mackie, secretary of the Oregon dairy council, Dr. MacPherson, A. D. Katz, ex-president of the dairymen's league, and Marshall N. Dana of the Journal.

DISSOLUTION POSSIBLE
If the Lower Columbia dairymen this afternoon refuse to accept the concessions which will be offered by the executive committee of the Oregon Dairyman's league and decline to reconsider their action in withdrawing from the league, the statewide association will be dissolved within a few days. The delegation which arrived here this morning was frank in stating this.

If this afternoon's effort at reconciliation results in failure a meeting of the general board of directors will be called for tomorrow to take steps looking to the dissolution of the league, it was stated plainly.

Contributing to this action is the general dissatisfaction which has spread through several of the zones other than the local one. It is understood that a meeting of the Washington county dairymen has been called for Saturday to consider action similar to that of the Clatsop county secessionists.

SECESSIONISTS FEEL THEY ARE IN FIRMER POSITION
Astoria, Nov. 7.—The executive committee of the Oregon Dairyman's league, together with a number of neutrals, who are nevertheless interested in the split between the state league and the former members of zone five, who seceded recently, are meeting today with the secessionists in an effort to heal the breach. The spirit of the league appears to be conciliatory.

The delegates representing the local zone five, which is now united as the Lower Columbia Dairy association, have steadfastly refused to give any hint as to the stand they will take regarding the overtures for peace, which are expected from the league.

CONDITIONS HELD BETTER
With dairy affairs in Clatsop county apparently in a less chaotic condition than they have been for months, with the prospects of the seceding dairymen being handled and sold and the prospect of securing the league plants in this area before them, the delegates from the local feel that they are in a firmer position than when they broke with the league a week ago, following the refusal of League Manager K. J. Eldridge to grant entire local control of some affairs.

It is thought that the league, on the other hand, has weakened, owing to the danger seen of the Clatsop withdrawal forcing the league from business and the expressed disagreement of the executive committee of the league with Manager Eldridge's stand.

It is forecasted here today that, providing the executive committee of the league is willing to grant the specific demands made by zone five before the rupture, the job-old dairymen in case of a possible failure of the league because of five months' milk for which they have not been paid.

It is expected that the local's delegates will prove inflexible in demanding acceptance of their ultimatum before considering peace. All of these points were agreed to by Manager Eldridge, save that the Clatsop zone should have complete management of the portion of its produce sold locally, together with the authority to name the local manager. It may be said that the stand of the executive committee of the state league on this point will determine the return or continued aloofness of the Lower Columbia district.

BANDITS SECURE \$8000 AT LIBERTY

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bound and gagged, she worked herself to a standing posture and knocked the telephone receiver from its hook, Miss Forbes was unfastening the ropes that bound her.

Charles had drawn the rag off his

eyes and he was released by Miss Forbes. That young lady then rushed to a telephone and it is said to have been nearly five minutes before she established a connection with police headquarters.

In the meantime the bandit trio had fled by the same door through which they entered, passing down the incline through the theatre and very probably escaping by a side entrance into Stark street.

Throughout the procedure the bandits had not spoken audibly, it is said, but went about their work methodically, although Miss Rotramel, who declares her only anxiety was for the safety of the auditor, declares the three men acted like they were amateurs. They were very ordinary clothes, one being in overalls, and because they were just like thousands of other men on the street, the victim believes it would be very difficult to identify them. Two of them appeared to be middle aged men, while the third was a young man, Miss Rotramel said.

The door through which the bandits entered the theatre office can only be reached through the theatre and the manner of the attack leads all who entered the office of the auditor and his staff and the "lay" of the Liberty theatre to believe certainly that the robbery received much preparatory attention and that the robbers knew just what to do and just when to do it.

BANDITS WERE WAITING
Charles is convinced that the bandits were waiting just outside the office door when he started to open the safe. The band that they heard the bell slide, releasing the lock on the safe door, the first of the three men snatched open the office door and instantly thrust a run toward Charles without saying a word.

Inspectors Cahill and Moloney, who were rushed to the theatre, believe that such details could not have been learned by robbers without much study of the activities of the auditor and an investigation of means of entry and exit at the theatre.

The money stolen by the robbers was the late Saturday and all day Sunday receipts which were to be banked today. The money was in the hands of the Jensen & Von Herberg theatre box offices today. News of the robbery spread rapidly among the Jensen & Von Herberg staff, inasmuch as the robbery just preceded the hour at which most managers report to the auditor to get their change sacks for the day.

The thieves apparently knew that the only persons apt to be in the theatre building at that hour would be in the office and that their entry and escape would probably be unnoticed. They were taking no chances, therefore, of being molested, until they actually reached the office door and the draperies and furnishings might have shielded them from sight while they listened for the opening of the safe door.

A ventilator at the top of the door leading to the balcony floor of the theatre made every sound in the theatre auditor's offices perfectly audible, as is indicated by the speed with which the men entered the room after the safe clicked open.

The loss is covered by burglar insurance, according to representatives of the Travelers' Insurance company, who were called to the theatre by the Jensen & Von Herberg staff.

BARNEY GIVES FIGHT
Harry Barney, who is night watchman and general utility man at the Liberty theatre, and who was one of the victims of the daring daylight holdup this morning, was a soldier in the Russian army throughout the Russo-Japanese war. He bears the reputation among members of the Liberty staff as being able to "fight his weight in wild cats," and is said never to have been known to decline a fight that promised lively action.

Therefore, when Barney discovered the thieves were in the office where he was chatting with R. E. Charles and Miss E. Rotramel, he set out to ston the robbers. He was successful in his attack, according to all reports, when unexpected reinforcements for the bandits arrived and the next thing Barney knew he was on the floor, regaining consciousness with his hands and feet tied and a gag in his mouth. His head bears witness to the effectiveness of the assault and he limps slightly from the pain of a wrenched knee.

"THAT GAT," SAYS CHARLES

R. E. Charles, Jensen & Von Herberg auditor, and the man who had just opened the office safe when the Liberty theatre bandits entered upon the scene, had only two thoughts when he realized that he was being robbed, he said this morning.

"Ye gods, what a gat," he exclaimed when he had regained his composure. "The only cannon as large that I ever saw was one we used to have here in the office. My first thoughts, of course, were for the safety of the money in the office, but after that I gave a whole lot of respectful attention to that gun."
