

CLAIM THEY PAID FOR BOOKS THAT THEY DIDN'T GET

Prominent lawyers, doctors and business men told a federal court jury Tuesday how Nicholas L. Cogan, book agent, had persuaded them to part with sums varying from \$19 to \$66 for a set of American history books which they never received.

Cogan, who represented himself as the Syndicate Press association, has swindled 500 people throughout the Northwest during the past two years, according to the statement to the jury of Assistant United States Attorney Hall Lusk.
